

Lesson 4: The Promise of Wisdom

- The Promise: The believer can trust in the Lord's promise of wisdom as it brings a sense of personal security, stability, and well being—Proverbs 3:21–26.
 - A. Realize that wisdom begins with God—Psalm 111:10.
 - **B.** Faith and wisdom are coupled together—1 Corinthians 2:4-7; Ephesians 1:15-17.
- II. Elements of the Promise
 - **A.** God gives it to the believer that asks—*James 1:5*.
 - **B.** A life of wisdom gives shelter and strength—*Ecclesiastes 7:12,19*.
 - C. Wisdom gives a desire to know the Lord better—Colossians 2:1–5; 2 Timothy 3:15.
 - **D.** Recognize that we have the capacity to live skillfully—*James 3:17; Proverbs 4:5–7.*
 - **E.** God's wisdom is infinite and unsearchable—*Psalm 147:5; Romans 11:33.*
 - F. God's wisdom is beyond wonderful and human comprehension—Psalm 139:6.
 - **G.** God's wisdom is perfect and mighty—*Job 36:4–5, 37:16*.
 - H. God's wisdom is seen in His works—*Psalm 104:24, 136:5; Proverbs 3:19; Jeremiah 10:12.*
 - I. God's wisdom is exhibited in knowing...
 - a. The hearts of men—Psalm 44:21; Proverbs 15:11; Luke 16:15.
 - b. The afflictions we face—Exodus 3:7, Psalm 42:3, Psalm 5–7.
 - c. The infirmities we face—Psalm 103:14–16.
 - J. God wisdom should be magnified—Romans 16:27.
- III. Walking in the Promise
 - A. Be humble, peaceful, and considerate—James 3:13–17.
 - **B.** Practice the Word of God in our daily lives—Colossians 3:16; 2 Timothy 3:16–17.
 - C. Remain mindful that wisdom is greater than the world's greatest treasures— Proverbs 8:11, 16:16; Job 28:15–19.
