Lesson 1: Reflecting God's Righteous Values — *Micah 1:1–16* Reggie Coe, Pastor to Senior Adults

- I. The introduction of God's messenger to His people—Micah 1:1
 - **A.** Micah's name means "Who is like Yahweh?"—Micah 1:1a.
 - **B.** His prophetic ministry was to both Samaria and Judah—*Micah 1:1b*.
- II. The call to consider God's message of judgment—Micah 1:2–16
 - **A.** God calls His people and all the nations to hear His case against Samaria and Judah, which was idolatry—*Micah* 1:2–5.
 - **B.** God's judgment would level the idolatrous northern kingdom—*Micah 1:6–7*.
- III. The lament of Micah for the coming judgment—*Micah 1:8–16*
 - **A.** Micah grieved the inevitability of judgment that awaited the Lord's people due to their incurable and infectious idolatry—*Micah 1:8–9*.
 - B. Micah used a series of word plays on the cities that would experience God's judgment—Micah 1:10–15.
 - C. Micah calls the people to mourn what will happen to the nation and to their children who will go into captivity—*Micah 1:16*.
