How do I sign up for a study or event? Paperless registration for everything is now available online through our website or the Church Center app on your smartphone. Visit gracechurch.com and click “Sign Up” on the front page or open Church Center and tap “Sign Up” in the menu at the bottom of the screen to get started.

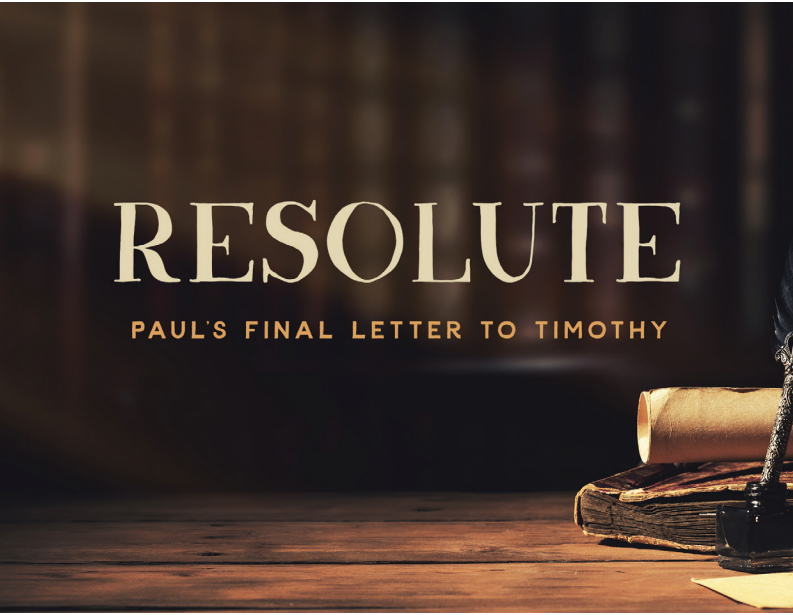
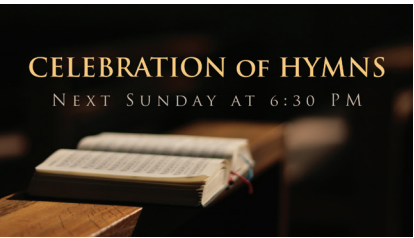

MESSAGE | 2 TIMOTHY 4:5–22

Resolute, Week 7: Charge, Cautions, and Commendations

- I. **Finishing Well:** Paul charged Timothy to remain faithful to God’s calling, which would require Timothy to follow Paul’s model of a sacrificial life—*2 Timothy 4:5–8*.

A. Paul exhorted Timothy to remain vigilant in these last days.

B. Paul reflected on having lived his life as a sacrifice and was eagerly awaiting the Lord’s commendation for remaining faithful in his “fight” and his “race”.
- II. **Take Note:** With his time growing short, Paul concludes his letter to Timothy by giving him five summary statements to provide guidance into the future—*2 Timothy 4:9–22*.

A. While the Lord may call some away to other ministries (Crescens and Titus), the lure of this world can shipwreck the earnest faith of others (Demas).

B. Paul graciously recounted those who remained faithful in their calling and continued to care for him (Luke, John Mark, Tychicus, and Timothy).

C. Paul warned Timothy there would be people, like Alexander, who would seek to harm him and be a hindrance to his calling.

D. Even though everyone deserted Paul, the Lord stood by him.

E. With his death imminent, Paul sent greetings to and from other faithful ministers and prayed for Timothy to remain grounded in the grace of God.
