The Parable of the Rich Fool—Luke 12:13-21

- Jesus used the opportunity of a family dispute to teach on the dangers of covetousness— Luke 12:13–15.
 - **A.** The request: Jesus was asked to settle a dispute over a brother's inheritance—

 Luke 12:13.
 - **B.** The refusal: Jesus refused to arbitrate the complaint—*Luke 12:14*.
 - **C.** The warning: Jesus warned against the dangers of covetousness—*Luke 12:15.*
- **II.** To illustrate his point, Jesus told a parable about a rich fool who had misdirected his wealth—*Luke 12:16–21*.
 - **A.** The setup: a rich man had more crops than he could store—*Luke 12:16–17*.
 - **B.** The plan: the rich man decided to build more barns to store and enjoy his wealth— *Luke 12:18–19.*
 - **C.** The reversal: the rich man died with nothing to show because he couldn't take his wealth with him—*Luke 12:20*.
 - **D.** The lesson: like the rich man who is poor in eternity, so all will be who are not rich towards God—*Luke 12:21*.
