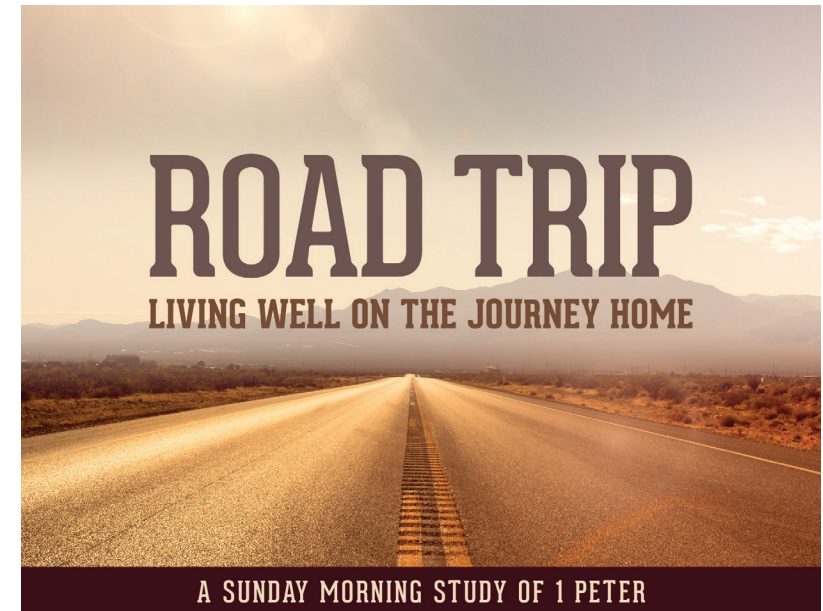

Road Trip, Lesson 5: Honor in Marriage
Lance Bourgeois, Senior Pastor

- I. **As a Wife:** The believing wife is to entrust herself to God as she honors her husband’s God-given role to lead the family—*1 Peter 3:1–6*.

A. She is to willingly yield to her husband’s leadership as her spiritual act of worship—*1 Peter 3:1-4*.

B. Sarah serves as an example of a godly wife as she demonstrated her faith by yielding to Abraham’s leadership and entrusting herself to God—*1 Peter 3:5-6*.
- II. **As a Husband:** The believing husband is to recognize his wife’s inherent worth and value as he sacrificially serves her according to her unique design—*1 Peter 3:7*.

A. He is to become a student of his wife—informed by her emotional, physical, and spiritual needs—so that he can serve and lead her well—*1 Peter 3:7a*.

B. God calls the husband to an incredible responsibility with the gifting of a wife—*1 Peter 3:7b*.

How does marriage point to Jesus and the church?
Husbands, what does it practically look like for you to live with your wife in an understanding way?
Wives, what does it practically look like for you to respect your husband?
Couples, share with your spouse what made you fall in love with them.
