Where do I learn more about Grace Church? 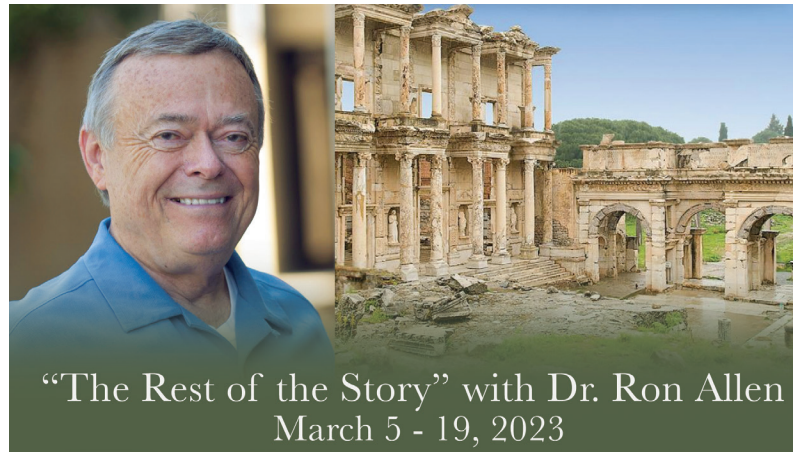

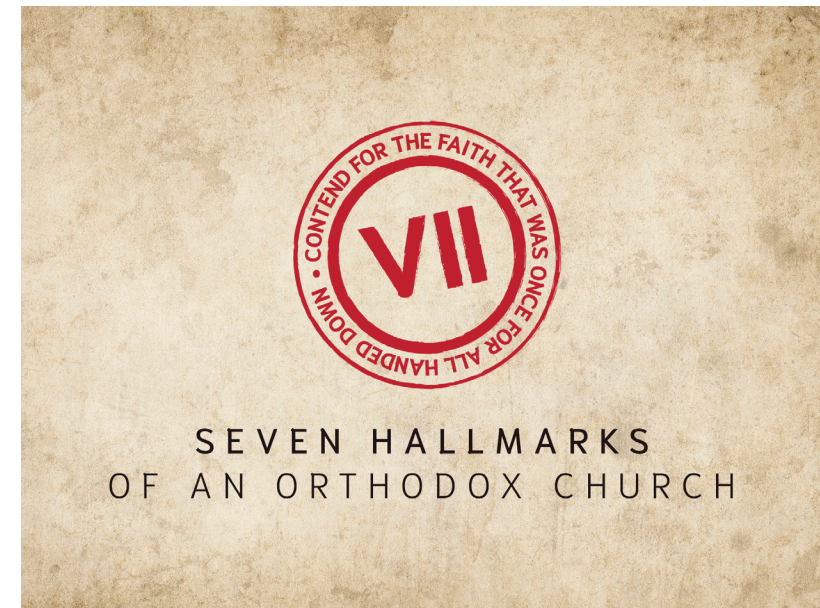
Lord's Supper Next Sunday

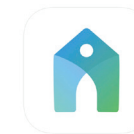


WELCOME

MESSAGE | SEVEN HALLMARKS

3: The Son

I. The full deity and humanity of Christ: God the Son became human in the Person of Jesus Christ; was conceived by the Holy Spirit within the womb of Mary, a virgin and is fully God and fully man—*Matthew 1:18*.
