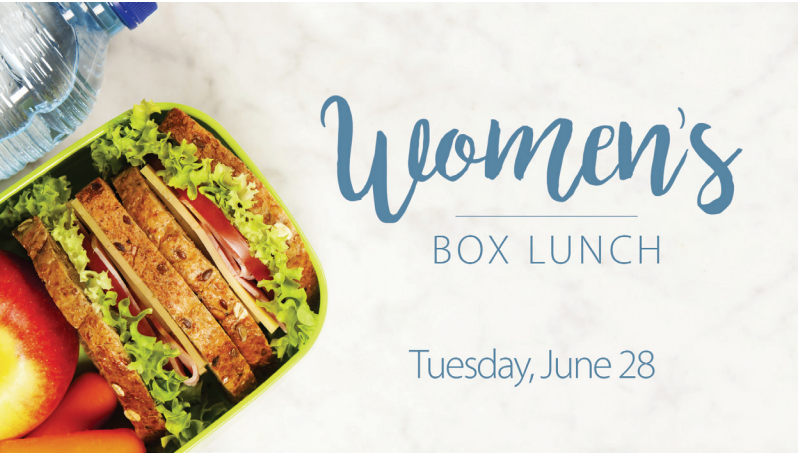

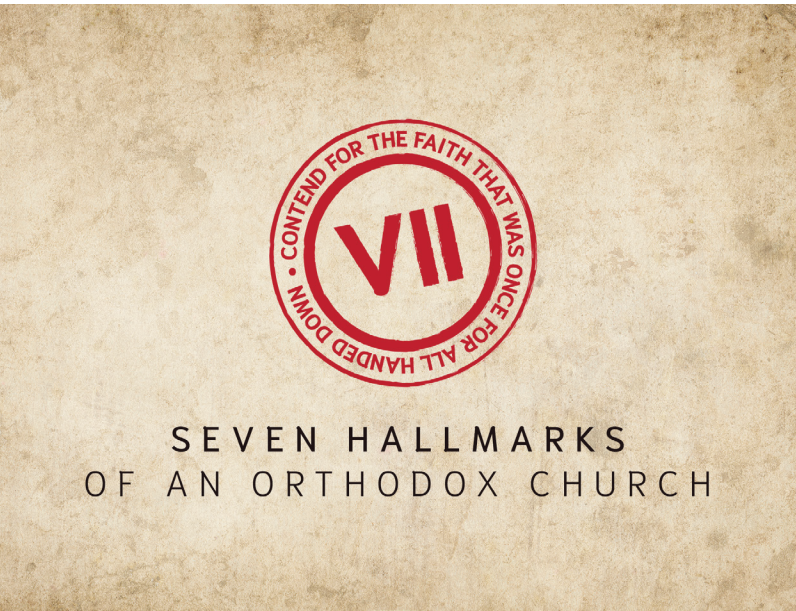

Week 6: Salvation

- I. The Doctrine of Salvation by Faith Alone in Christ Alone
- The foundational doctrine of Christian orthodoxy: the resurrection
  - The foundational doctrine of the Christian life: salvation through faith alone in Christ alone

II. The Problem and the Solution

**The Problem:** What is our biggest obstacle to understanding and embracing this truth?

1. Saved *from* what?
  - The consequences of sin—*Romans 3:23*
  - The power of sin—*Romans 6:20–21; 7:14–15, 18–20*
2. Saved *for* what?
  - Restored (eternal) relationship with our Creator—*Revelation 21:5–7*
  - Good works—*Ephesians 2:10*
3. Saved *by* what?—*Ephesians 2:8–9*
  - *By* grace
  - *Through* faith

A. The Solution: How can we embrace this truth?

1. **Acknowledge** my insufficiency— *Romans 3:23*.
2. **Recognize** God’s plan for me— *Revelation 21:5–7; 1 Thessalonians 4:3; Ephesians 2:10*.
3. **Embrace** Christ’s work for me.

III. Living by Faith: This doctrine offers us two truths that can anchor our lives...

1. Assurance of our eternal destiny with Christ— *1 John 5:13*
2. The ability to walk in the newness of life each and every day— *Romans 6:4*
