Lesson 1: Understanding Discipleship

- **I.** Understanding the indispensability of discipleship: The Lord Jesus Christ chose discipleship as His means to reach the entire world with His life-changing message of grace.
- II. Understanding the Great Commission: The central mandate in the Savior's final commission to His followers is to "make disciples", as we go into the world, being sure to baptize and teach those who respond to the message of grace—Matthew 28:18–20.
- **III.** Understanding flawed perceptions of discipleship: Discipleship is frequently misunderstood as a program or system, instead of the cultivation of a growing relationship with Jesus Christ.
- **IV.** Understanding the word "disciple": The concept of a "disciple" (Greek *mathetes*) has evolved from its use in early Greek literature to its use by the Son of God in His ministry on earth.
- V. Understanding the pathway of discipleship: The word "disciple" is used in four different ways in the gospels and Book of Acts, which together create a life-long pathway of relating to Jesus Christ.
 - **A.** A curious disciple is a person who is drawn to Jesus Christ in order to study His claims and His teaching—*Matthew 6:60–66; John 2:11.*
 - **B.** A convinced disciple is a person who has believed in Jesus Christ as his personal Savior—John 6:67–69.


There are three types of convinced disciples, including secret ones (John 19:38), carnal ones (1 Corinthians 3:1–3), and healthy ones (Acts 11:25–26).

- **C.** A committed disciple is a person who has submitted to the authority of Jesus Christ and has begun to yield specific areas of his life to Him—*Luke 14:33*.
- D. A commissioned disciple is a person who has devoted himself to serve the Lord's agenda—Matthew 28:16–20.

VI.	Understanding our mission as a church: The purpose of Grace Church is to raise up mature disciples of Jesus Christ.
