Lesson 1: God, My Guide

- I. **Calling Out to the Lord:** David began his day by bringing his troubled heart to the Lord—*Psalm 5:1–3*.

A. Please hear me—*Psalm 5:1*.

B. Please respond to me—*Psalm 5:2*.

C. I will worship as I wait—*Psalm 5:3*.

- II. **The Battlefield:** David was overwhelmed by the wickedness that he saw all around him—*Psalm 5:4–6*.

- III. **The Comforting Conviction:** As he was surrounded by wickedness, David rested in the knowledge that God judges wickedness and provides refuge for those who trust in Him—*Psalm 5:7–12*.
