- Mary's story holds our attention: Mary's story is truly captivating. She I. was a young, unknown girl eagerly anticipating a simple village marriage when her entire world was unexpectedly transformed. This unassuming young woman has since become perhaps the most widely recognized woman in human history — Luke 1:26-38
  - **Q** Further Reference: Matthew 18:1-4

- Mary's story stirs our emotion: Mary's unique assignment would impact II. the entire world. However, it came at a great personal cost, as her life was marked by scandal, hardship, and sorrow — Matthew 1:18–19
  - **Q** Further Reference: John 8:39, 48; Mark 2:16–17, 6:3; Isaiah 53:3

Mary's story helps us remember: Mary's life of faithfulness is a powerful III. reminder of how our individual stories, no matter how small they may seem, beautifully intertwine with the larger narrative that God continues to write — Luke 1:46-55
