THE CORINTHIAN CONUNDRUM

Lesson 5: The Characteristics and Cure for Carnality (1 Corinthians 3:1–17)

- I. The characteristics of carnality: prolonged immaturity and inappropriate devotion to leaders—*1 Corinthians 3:1–8*.
 - A. Prolonged immaturity reveals a lack of dependence upon the Holy Spirit and evidences itself through an inability to digest solid Biblical truth—*1 Corinthians 3:1–2*.

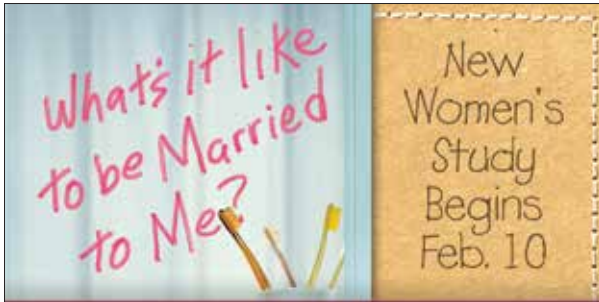
Inappropriate devotion to leaders causes divisions in the body of Christ and credits the leaders with things that only the Lord can do—*1 Corinthians 3:3–8*.

 - Exclusive loyalty to a human leader reveals carnality and causes unhealthy divisions within a church body—*1 Corinthians 3:3–4*.
 - Healthy spiritual leaders view themselves humbly as servants of the Lord—*1 Corinthians 3:5*.
 - The work of healthy spiritual leaders consists of planting and nurturing God's truth in people's lives—*1 Corinthians 3:6a*.
 - The Lord alone causes healthy spiritual growth and He alone deserves our loyalty and devotion—*1 Corinthians 3:6–7*.
 - Every spiritual leader will receive his or her reward from the Lord—*1 Corinthians 3:8*.
- II. The cure for carnality: We live free from carnality when we live in the grace of God, looking toward His assessment of our lives at the judgment seat of Christ—*1 Corinthians 3:9–17*.
 - A. God views believers as His field and His building—*1 Corinthians 3:9*.
 - B. Motivated by the grace of God, we build upon Christ, Who is the foundation of our lives—*1 Corinthians 3:10–11*.
 - C. At the judgment seat of Christ, each believer's life will be tested to see if he or she built through carnal means (wood, hay, straw) or spiritual means (gold, silver, precious stones)—*1 Corinthians 3:12–13*.
 - D. This judgment determines rewards, not eternal destiny—*1 Corinthians 3:14–15*.
 - E. God dwells in believers and thus we are His holy dwelling place—*1 Corinthians 3:16–17*.
