Asian Christian Academy



Lesson 10: Sexual Immorality and the Sacred Purpose of the Human Body (1 Corinthians 6:12–20)

- I. **The nature of our freedom:** The freedom we have in Jesus Christ is intended to prompt us to pursue those things that will be beneficial, but will not dominate our lives—*1 Corinthians 6:12*.
- II. **The importance of our body:** The importance of the human body is based on God’s eternal purpose for it, in contrast, for example, to our digestive organs, which do not have a function in eternity—*1 Corinthians 6:13*.
- III. **The destiny of our body:** The eternal importance of the human body is solidified by God’s decision to physically resurrect it in the same manner as the body of the Lord Jesus Christ—*1 Corinthians 6:14*.
- IV. **The violation with our body:** Joining our body to a person other than our marriage partner is a blatant violation of our “body, soul, and spirit” union with Jesus Christ—*1 Corinthians 6:15*.
- V. **The consequence to our body:** Sexual engagement with a person outside our marriage creates a “one body” union, which is incompatible with a “one flesh” union with a spouse and a “one spirit” union with Jesus Christ—*1 Corinthians 6:16–17*.
- VI. **The protection of our body:** Running away from sexual temptation is essential to protect ourselves from violating the sacred purpose of our bodies (cp. Genesis 39:6b–12)—*1 Corinthians 6:18*.
- VII. **The use of our body:** Our bodies are only to be used in ways that honor God Who has purchased us out of bondage to sin and made them His eternal home —*1 Corinthians 6:19–20*.
 - A. The believer’s body is the home and “holy of holies” of the Holy Spirit—*1 Corinthians 6:19a*.
 - B. God exclusively owns us, because Jesus Christ purchased us out of bondage to sin with His pure and priceless life—*1 Corinthians 6:19b–20a*.
 - C. Our responsibility is to use our bodies to express the character of the One Who owns and indwells us—*1 Corinthians 6:20b*.
