THE CORINTHIAN CONUNDRUM

Lesson 19: Men and Women in Public Ministry (1 Corinthians 11:2–16)

- I. Affirmation of the Corinthian church—*1 Corinthians 11:2*.
- II. Correction of the Corinthian church: Paul addresses how believers conduct themselves in public ministry outside of the church gathered—*1 Corinthians 11:3–16*.
 - A. Paul does not address issues of their conduct in the church gathered until he addresses their abuses of the Lord’s Supper—*1 Corinthians 11:18*.
 - B. He begins with the central focus of headship—*1 Corinthians 11:3*.
 - C. When ministering in a public context, a man who ministers with his head covered dishonors his head, Christ—*1 Corinthians 11:4*.
 - D. When ministering in a public context, a woman who ministers with her head uncovered dishonors her head, her husband—*1 Corinthians 11:5*.
 - E. The context is ministry outside the sphere of the local church—*1 Corinthians 11:6*, see *1 Corinthians 11:18*; *1 Corinthians 14:34*; *2 Timothy 2:12*; *Acts 21:10–11*.
 - F. Paul addresses the issue from God’s creation of Adam and Eve—*1 Corinthians 11:7–9*, see *Genesis 2:18–23*.
 - G. Paul includes the significance of angelic instruction—*1 Corinthians 11:10*, see *1 Peter 1:12*; *1 Corinthians 4:9*; *Ephesians 3:10*.
 - H. Paul stresses the reality of the equality of men and women—*1 Corinthians 11:11–12*.
 - I. Paul focuses on the general idea that men and women are different and basically look different—*1 Corinthians 11:13–15*.
 - J. Paul intends this to be the pattern for behavior of believers in ministry outside of the local church—*1 Corinthians 11:16*.
