 - 🔍 *Further Reference: Job 38:3; 2 Timothy 2:4*

- v. God sends Isaiah to deliver a heavy message to the people of Judah — Isaiah 6:9–13
 - 🔍 *Further Reference: Romans 1:18, 1:24–25; Isaiah 30:9–11, 30:15; Revelation 1:12–18*
