What the Future Holds- Biblical Prophecy Lesson 6—The False Prophet

- I. **How is the false prophet described?** The Bible identifies the one we call the false prophet with several terms.
 - A. He is referred to as another beast which focuses on his sharing the same character as the first beast whom we understand to be the antichrist—*Revelation 13:11–18.*
 - B. He is also referred to as the false prophet which sees him at the source of error and his ministry is fueled by deception—*Revelation 16:13; 19:20; 20:10.*
- II. What will be the false prophet's character? The false prophet will look godly but will be empowered by Satan and will be a wolf in sheep's clothing
 - A. He will have great authority (two horns) and will appear to be righteous (like a lamb) and will work to persuade people into thinking he is a godly person—*Revelation* 13:11a.
 - B. He will actually be empowered by Satan and his teaching and world view will be satanic to the core—*Revelation 13:11b.*
 - C. He will perform satanic miracles, much like the magicians in Pharaoh's day that will deceive many during the tribulation period—*Revelation 13:16–18.*
- III. What will the false prophet do? The activity of the false prophet will center on directing people to worship the antichrist and establishing a global economy.
 - A. His miracles will appear to duplicate the miracles of the 2 witnesses in Revelation 11 and he will use his power to deceive people during the tribulation to worship the antichrist—*Revelation 11; 13:12–14.*
 - B. He will create an image of the beast that he will appear to bring to life and persecute those who will not worship the image to be put to death—*Revelation 13:15; 14:9–13.*
 - C. He will develop an economy that will require people to take upon themselves the mark of the beast in order to buy and sell—*Revelation 13:16–18.*
 - D. He will, in conjunction with Satan and the antichrist, send forth demonic forces to gather the armies of the world for battle—*Revelation 16:12-14.*
- IV. What is the destiny of the false prophet? The false prophet will be defeated at the return of Christ and will be thrown into the lake of fire along with the antichrist—*Revelation 19:20; 20:10.*
