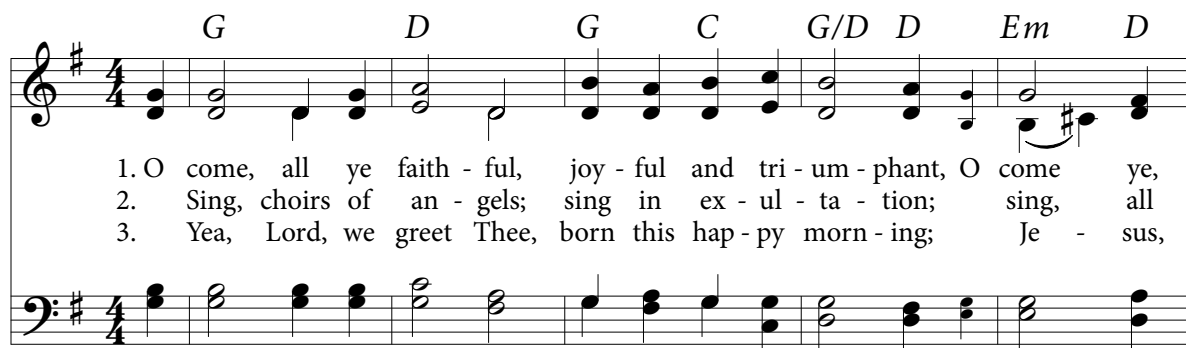


O Come, All Ye Faithful

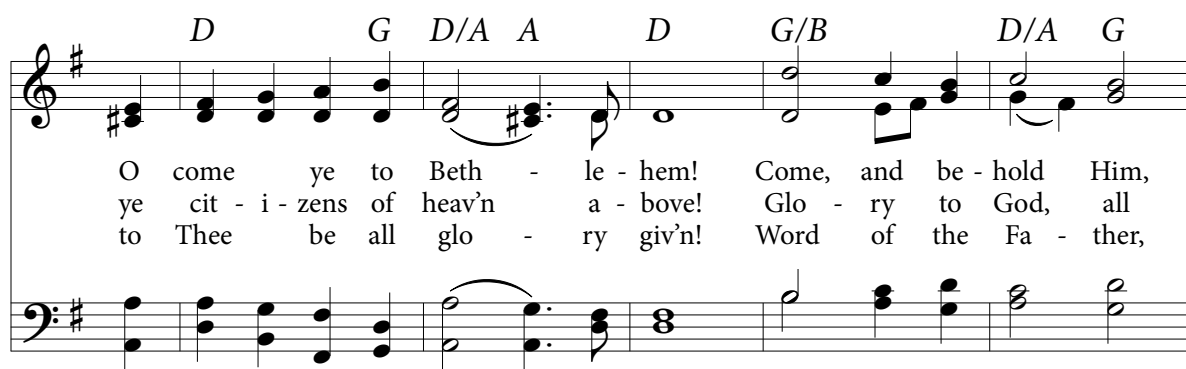

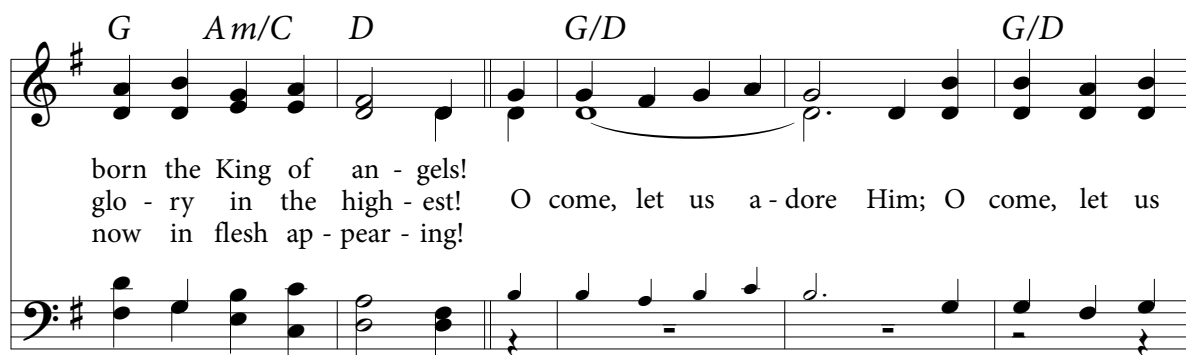
