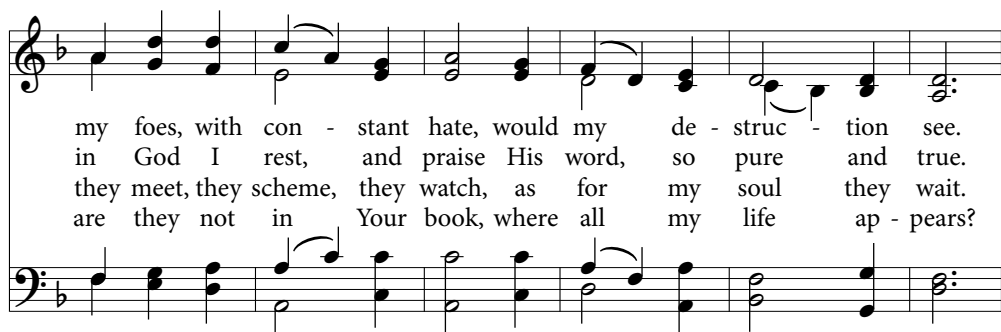


O God, Be Merciful
