John 6:5-14

1. Jesus took 12 ordinary men and gave them the opportunity of a lifetime. He chose them not so much because of who they were, but because of what they could become.
2. Even though he was almost always in the shadow of his brother, the apostle Andrew was someone who made it his mission to point men to Christ as the answer.
3. The picture we get of Andrew is that he is always faith in action: putting it all in the Savior’s hands.
