"Putting it All in the Savior's Hands" John 6:5-14

- 1. Jesus took 12 ordinary men and gave them the opportunity of a lifetime. He chose them no so much because of who they were, but because of what they could become.
- 2. Even though he was almost always in the shadow of his brother, the apostle Andrew was someone who made it his mission to point men to Christ as the answer.
- 3. The picture we get of Andrew is that he is always faith in action: putting it all in the Savior's hands.
