- 1. We are interested in what matters most. We have our obligations to our jobs, to our families, to our congregation, but most of all, always to the Lord.
- 2. Jesus in being asked what commandment was greatest pointed to Deuteronomy 6:5. He also quotes from Leviticus 19:18 in showing the need for loving neighbors as self. In short, Jesus wants us to be "Christ-centered."
- 3. When we couple these verses with the responsibility of Matthew 6:33, we come to the understanding that Jesus wants us to be a "Christ-centered, kingdom-loving" individual.
