- 1. "Indispensable" means "absolutely essential." What things in your life are absolutely essential to you? What things can you not "do without?"
- 2. All throughout the book of John, Jesus shows Himself to be the One in truth who we as humanity absolutely cannot do without (John 1:3-4; John 1:29; John 3:16; John 12:48-50; John 15:5; John 20:30-31)!
- 3. In John 14, Jesus is about to go to the cross. He knows that it will result in His death and as He tells His disciples these things, their hearts are overwhelmed with sorrow. Yet, Jesus assures them that it to their benefit that He goes to the cross because in Him, the way is cleared for all men to come to the Father.
- 4. Because of His redemptive work, God has purposed Jesus to be indispensable to our salvation! John 14:6 has so much emphasis on who He is, but it begs the question, "what are we?"
