

TAG QUESTIONS

1. Introduction and Use

We frequently use tag questions in English **when we want someone to agree or disagree (confirmation)**.

2. Two forms of tag questions:

- positive statement → question tag negative.

They are students, aren't they?

- negative statement → question tag positive.

She isn't Sara, is she?

3. Examples

3.1. with auxiliaries

- You **have** a car, **don't** you?

3.2. with modals

We **mustn't** wait here, **must** we?

I **should** start now, **shouldn't** I?

Children **can't** drive, **can** they?

You **will** come tomorrow, **won't** you?

3.3. without auxiliaries (*don't, doesn't, didn't*)

- My friends **swim** on Fridays, **don't** they?
- Sara **cooks** on weekends, **doesn't** she?
- Ali **played** football last week, **didn't** he?
