GUIDELINES

- ✓ Plant and Flower Entries will be accepted beginning at 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday.
- ✓ **IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT EACH ENTRY HAVE THE NAME OF EXHIBITOR ON BOTTOM OF VASE OR CONTAINER.**
- ✓ **ALL PLANTS MUST BE GROWN IN CONTAINER IN WHICH IT IS EXHIBITED FOR THE PAST 6 WEEKS.**
- ✓ Foliage on cut flowers should be carefully removed below the water line.
- ✓ Exhibitors are encouraged to replenish with fresh flowers when they show signs of withering, especially bouquets and arrangements, or special prize winners.
- ✓ **PLANTS AND FLOWERS MUST BE GROWN IN YOUR OWN GARDEN AND ARRANGED BY THE EXHIBITOR.**
- ✓ **NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 8:00 A.M. ON THURSDAY.**
- ✓ The purpose of this class of exhibits is to encourage the production of flowers by all; hence, this class is open to amateurs only. Nurseries and florists may exhibit personally grown flowers but are barred from competition in Lot 3.
- ✓ It is recommended that all plants and flowers should be carefully named and state what lot they are entered in.
- ✓ Exhibitors must supply all material and containers for bouquets.
- ✓ The judges shall have power to award or withhold premiums according to merit of exhibit.
- ✓ All exhibits will be released at 6:30 p.m. on Sunday.
- ✓ Judging shall be according to the following rules and scales of points:
 1. Cut flowers: condition – 25; variety – 25; value – 25; size regards to specimens – 25.
 2. Flowering plants: size – 20; foliage – 20; floriferousness – 20; color – 10; cultural perfection – 30.
 3. Bouquets: harmony of color – 30; arrangement – 40; quality of bloom – 20; harmony of flowers and container – 10.
