Ryan Preble, County Manager, will introduce Elliot Clark, Regional Director of Community Relations for Vaya Health. Mr. Clark will share the most recent data dashboard activity for Franklin County. Vaya Health is the Local Management Entity/Managed Care Organization (LME/MCO) that oversees Medicaid, federal, state, and local funding for services and supports resources for mental health, substance use disorder, and intellectual disabilities.

4. **APPOINTMENTS**

A. [Firemen's Relief Fund Board of Trustees \(Youngsville Fire District\)](#)

The Board is asked to consider appointing Andrew Dudash and Harold (Bud) Holden to the Firemen's Relief Fund Board of Trustees for Youngsville Fire District. Pursuant to NCGS § 58-84-30, each county deriving benefits from the provisions of this Article, shall appoint a local board of trustees, known as the trustees of the local Firefighters' Relief Fund, to be composed of five members, two of whom shall be elected by the members of the local fire department who are qualified as beneficiaries of such fund, two of whom shall be elected by the mayor and board of aldermen or other local governing body, and one of whom shall be named by the State Fire Marshal. Appointments made by the local governing body shall be residents of the fire districts and serve at the pleasure of the governing body. There is no term limit for relief board members.

ACTION REQUESTED: Consider appointing Andrew Dudash and Harold (Bud) Holden to the Youngsville Fire District's Firemen's Relief Fund Board of Trustees.
