Kindergarten

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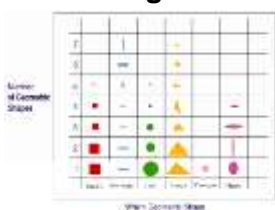
Geometry Friends – Creating and personifying geometry friends

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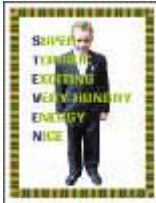
The Animal Inside Me – Creating a family album with the animals that relate to our inner selves.

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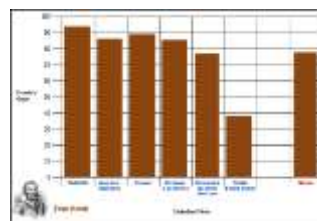
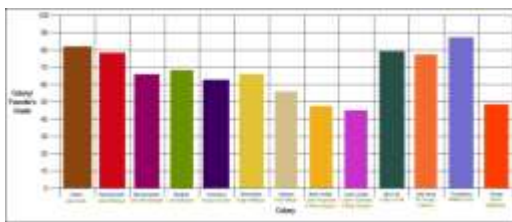
My Life as an American Patriot – Studying the American Revolutionary War with digital time travel

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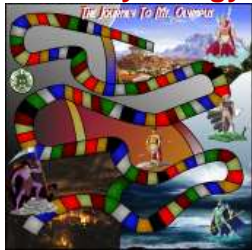
