

Gform post submission

From GravityForms

Description

This action hook is executed at the end of the submission process (after form validation, notification, and entry creation). Use this hook to perform actions after the entry has been created (i.e. feed data to third party applications). The Entry Object is available to this hook and contains all submitted values

Usage

Applies to all forms

```

Applies to a specific form. In this case, form Id 5

Parameters

\$entry

(Entry Object) The entry that was just created.

\$form

(Form Object) The current form.

This example uses the gform_post_submission hook to change the post content, adding values from submitted fields, including an image field
