

OM Lake T Ministry update

Greetings to you from OM Lake Tanganyika.

We are thankful to God for His faithfulness, for His love and guidance upon the Team as we strive towards His culture and excellence. God is indeed our Ebenezer! We are grateful to God for His continuous love and kindness to the Team as we continue to serve in the villages along Lake T in Zambia and in Burundi. We thank God for the young people whom He is raising through church mobilization and our daily disciple making. Six notable disciples have undergone MDT/Reach Training including two young men from Burundi. We desire to see the team expanding for His glory, we are happy that Peter, Ired, Frank and Lighton have completed the training and have come to serve with us; whilst Ferdinand, Feniwick and Samson, two Burundians and one Zambian are going to complete the training in July and join the team for long term missions work.

We thank God for what He is doing in the lives of these young people and their passion for the lost. We hope to see God using them effectively for His glory. Pray with us for God's continued provision as we desire a great movement of young men and women, joining us in His work here at Lake T Field and in the Sahel region. We are inviting you fellow believers to consider journeying with us as we mobilize the local church and individuals to go into His vineyard. For the harvest truly is plentiful but the workers are few. Let us call earnestly on the Owner of the harvest to send more laborers into the field.

The Good News II Orphan School/OM Lake Tanganyika Trust School- We are seeing God's hand upon the school building project at the new site, with the first block of 4 classrooms, two offices, toilet facilities and a water solar system. We have almost reached the finishing phase. We thank God for the connection with the community people that we have through the school building project. The people from the community are grateful to God for the school, as they have been sending their kids far distances away for school. Now that the school is there, they desire their children to attend our school in the future. We hope to reach out to the community with the Gospel, as new relationships are formed.

Planting Seeds- Jacob* attended OMLTTS for many years as a student. The teachers faithfully shared the Word and love of God with him every day. After completing grade 7, he was sponsored by the school to attend grade 8 at a government school. However, shortly afterwards he disappeared and went back to one of the villages along the Lake. The teachers lost track of him and wondered what would happen to him. Jacob showed up one day at the Church of one of the teachers and confidently stood in front of everyone and pointed to the teacher saying, "this is the teacher who shared the gospel with me in class and I became born again right there at school." He went on to explain that he had attended OMLTTS and there the teachers had shared the word of God with him. They talked about salvation and repentance and one day he gave his life to God. Since then he has become a different person. He is really committed to God and his behavior has changed for the good. He wants to get baptized and he is a regular attendee at Church and Youth group. He encourages the other youths in the group meetings, that they can work together to develop their relationship with God, He has also declared that he exists to share his faith with others. Through Jacob, his grandparents have begun to attend Church and they have received Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior.

Medical Outreach- God continues to use us through the medical outreach ministry. In the month of June the Medical Team went to Crocodile Island for an outreach. There is no health facility or clean running water at the Island. People believe in witchcraft and consult the witchdoctors every time. We attended to over 500 persons who came with different health challenges. These persons were then prayed for, we thank God that a number of those whom we assisted could go back to their homes delivered from spiritual attacks, no longer in need of medical attention. Conducting the medical outreach on the Island has opened the door for ministry and we have a church that was planted by OM Lake T Missionaries in partnership with one of the existing local churches in Mpulungu. The need is great and we trust God for more of His provision to continue conducting the medical outreaches in the villages around the Lake T.

Intended OM Lake T Sustainable Projects

Please pray for the OM Lake T sustainable projects. As a field we are praying for God's provision to build ministry Flats that can help us to raise income to support the ministries. We have a property that we hope to develop by putting up few Flats, as new persons that come to serve with us sometimes have struggles to find a home.

Please pray that that these Flats would be provided to meet the needs of the Ministry and to serve those who come to work alongside the team. God has done a lot for the ministry and we know that He is there for us still for His glory.
