### **Monday , July 22, 2019 - Biltmore**

Visit America's largest home, built by George Vanderbilt. Explore the 8000-acre beautiful and grand estate in the Blue Ridge Mountains of Asheville, NC. A motorcoach bus will pick us up at the campground at 9:00am to take us to the Biltmore for a self guided tour of the beautiful home, the Winery, Gardens and the Antler shopping village.

### **Tuesday, July 23 , 2019 - Cherokee Indian Reservation & Casino**

The 56,000-acre [Cherokee Indian Reservation](#) is home to more than 10,000 Eastern Band of the Cherokee members. Each year, thousands of visitors from across the country

come to discover this enchanted land and to share the natural mountain beauty the Cherokee have treasured for centuries.

The Oconaluftee Indian Village, located on the **Cherokee Indian Reservation**, is an authentic replica of an 18th century Cherokee village and offers guided and self-guided tours to explore the village with dwellings, residents, and artisans right out of the 1750's. Visitors can experience traditional medicine and interact with villagers as they hull canoes, make pottery and masks, weave baskets and beadwork, and participate in their daily activities. The Village also hosts live reenactments, interactive demonstrations, "Hands-On Cherokee" arts and crafts classes, Villager outfit rentals for children, and evening storytelling performances.

Departing the campground at 1:00pm in a motorcoach bus.

Arriving at the Cherokee / Oconaluftee Indiana Reservation at 2:00pm

Departing the reservation at 5:00pm and taken to the Harrah's Casino for dinner and/or shopping. which will be on your own.

Departing the casino at 7:00pm for a return trip back to the reservation for a show "Unto These Hills" . One of America's most popular outdoor dramas of the tragic and triumphant story of the Cherokee Indians. Performed under the stars on 3 stages in the Mountainside Theater. This 2 hour show ( 15 minute intermission ) runs from 8:00pm-10:00pm. Pre-show starts 40 minutes prior.

Departing the reservation at 10:00pm for our return to the campground.

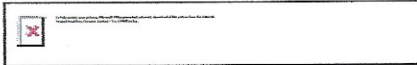
