

Biography of Dr. Anthony Loizides

Dr. Anthony Loizides graduated from S.U.N.Y. Stony Brook School of Medicine, was a resident in pediatrics at the same institution, and completed his fellowship in pediatric gastroenterology at The Combined Program in Pediatric Gastroenterology and Nutrition at the Harvard Medical School, training at both Children's Hospital Boston and Massachusetts General Hospital. He is involved in education from the medical school to the faculty level by giving talks to medical students, residents, fellows and attending physicians both at CHAM and at other institutions. He has over 20 publications in original research as well as invited reviews, chapters, and editorials.

Dr. Loizides' interests include inflammatory bowel disease, gastroenterological consequences of Rett and other syndromes as well as eosinophilic esophagitis and food allergy. He has been at the Children's Hospital at Montefiore since 2004.
