

Tulips and Windmills

Admire the genius of the Dutch Masters at Amsterdam's Rijksmuseum. Explore Hoorn's seafaring heritage, Arnhem's World War II history and Antwerp's Renaissance splendor. Step into the Middle Ages in Bruges. Sample Belgian beers and chocolates. See colorful ribbons of farmland as Dutch tulips come into bloom. Roam Keukenhof Gardens, the world's largest floral park. The best time to see the Low Countries is spring, and the best way to see them is on our 10-day cruise.









SATURDAY, APRIL 21

Day 1 · Departure Day

Our exciting journey begins as we board our flight bound for Europe. Months of anticipation and preparation make this day a most welcome arrival.

SUNDAY, APRIL 22 | D

Day 2 · Arrive Amsterdam

Arrive in Amsterdam. We are met at the airport and transferred to our ship. After boarding, you are free to get acquainted with this canal-laced city.

MONDAY, APRIL 23 | BLD

Day 3 · Amsterdam

After breakfast, we embark on a canal tour by glass-topped boat to see architecture from the city's Golden Age. Return aboard for lunch, then we have free time to visit the Anne Frank House, the Van Gogh Museum, or just explore the city's charming neighbourhoods.

TUESDAY, APRIL 24 | BLD

Day 4 · Hoorn

After breakfast, we enjoy a guided walk through Hoorn's cobbled streets; see age-old cheese warehouses on the town's main square, which dates back to Holland's Golden Age. Lunch is served aboard: we have a free afternoon to explore Hoorn, visit a local bakery and shop for souvenirs. Or, take an optional excursion showcasing the small towns and bucolic landscapes of the northern Holland area. We depart later this evening and cruise through the night.

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 25 | BLD

Day 5 · Arnhem

After an early arrival in Arnhem, we take a journey to 17th-century Paleis Het Loo, for 300 years the Dutch royal family's summer residence. Take a guided tour through its sumptuously furnished rooms and beautifully landscaped gardens. After lunch aboard, we enjoy free time, or join the optional battlefield tour that also visits the Airborne Museum. If the Palace is closed, a battlefield visit or museum tour will be substituted.

THURSDAY, APRIL 26 | BLD

Day 6 · Kinderdijk

We arrive this morning in Kinderdijk and disembark for a tour of this ingenious 18th-century community. Learn why the windmills were built and see how they work to help control flooding, then tour an actual working windmill to see its pumping mechanism and living quarters at this UNESCO World Heritage Site. Lunch aboard as we sail toward Antwerp.



FRIDAY, APRIL 27 | BLD

Day 7 · Antwerp

This morning we enjoy a half-day tour of Antwerp featuring the Cathedral of Our Lady with its three

monumental altarpieces painted by Peter Paul Rubens; the Grote Markt (Grand Square) surrounded by the Golden Age Town Hall and guild halls, and Het Steen (Steen Castle), Antwerp's oldest building. We have free time this afternoon and tonight we sail for Ghent.



SATURDAY, APRIL 28 | BLD

Day 8 · Ghent - Bruges

From Ghent we travel by motorcoach to Bruges, one of the oldest towns in Flanders. Our city walk visits the Church of Our Lady, with its famous Madonna and Child sculpted by Michelangelo. We also see the Beguinage, a hidden courtyard inhabited by nuns, and the town's scenic network of canals. Stay in Bruges for lunch on our own, or return to Ghent for lunch aboard and an afternoon exploring this extraordinarily charming, canal-filled capital of East Flanders. Enjoy a beautifully lit evening departure from Ghent and cruise through the night.

SUNDAY, APRIL 29 | BLD

Day 9 · Delta Works - Rotterdam

After breakfast travel to the region of Walcheren, formerly an island of the southwest Netherlands. We stop in Veere and enjoy a walking tour of this engaging, time-honored town. From here, we go to the Delta Works, the ingenious system of enormous doors that can be lowered during spring tides to protect the area from floods while allowing the tides to ebb and flow. We rejoin our ship, which has sailed on to Bruinisse, for lunch and afternoon sailing. This evening, we arrive in Rotterdam, the world's second largest port. After an onboard dinner, we have free time to explore the city. It has been significantly rebuilt after much World War II destruction, and some of its architecture is quite innovative.

MONDAY, APRIL 30 | BLD

Day 10 · Keukenhof Gardens - Amsterdam

After breakfast, we take a journey to picturesque Keukenhof Gardens, the world's largest floral park. Admire the stunning beauty at both indoor and outdoor exhibits of millions of vibrant blooms including tulips, hyacinths, croci and daffodils. The rest of the day is ours to discover Amsterdam's hidden treasures. Choose to explore Museum Square, take a bike ride, or shop for colourful clogs and tulip bulbs. Dinner is served aboard, followed by free time to enjoy Amsterdam's nightlife.

RESERVATIONS

A deposit of \$500 is required to reserve your place on this tour, of which \$100 is non-refundable.

FINAL PAYMENT

The final payment for your river cruise is due July 25,2017. A reminder will be sent to passengers in advance of this date.

CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS

For payments made by credit card, we reserve the right to have credit card charges processed by the suppliers of travel services such as the airline, cruise line, etc. If this occurs, your payment will be split between Rostad Tours and the other suppliers and will appear as separate payments on your credit card statement.

SHARED & SINGLE ACCOMMODATION

You must indicate at the time of booking whether you want to share a room or if you prefer a single room. Your roommate if known, should also be indicated.

RESERVATION CHANGES

If you want to change your reservation, such as change your departure city or plan an extended stay, you must submit your request to Rostad Tours in writing via mail or email (flights@rostad.com) at least four months prior to departure. Any subsequent changes, cancellations of extension arrangements or changes requested within four months of departure are subject to a service fee of \$100 per person in addition to any fees charged by the various travel suppliers.

CANCELLATIONS

If you cancel, you will receive back all money paid towards the tour less the applicable cancellation fee and any insurance premium paid. The charges apply to the base price of the cruise only and do not include cancellation charges for any extra arrangements, such as flights, extensions, etc.

INSURANCE

We recommend that you purchase insurance at the time you make your final payment to protect yourself against any possible cancellation charges or out-of-country medical expenses. An all-inclusive policy which has cancellation, hospital/medical and baggage coverage will be offered to Alberta residents prior to making their final payment. For passengers residing outside of Alberta, we will explain how you can obtain our special group rates for travel insurance direct from Old Republic Insurance Group. If you are considering using your credit card company's insurance coverage, we strongly suggest you verify that they will reimburse the full amount of any cancellation charges.

PASSPORTS

A passport is required for all tour participants. For this tour your passport must be valid for at least six months past your intended return date. If you do not already have a passport, or if your current passport will expire within this period, apply for your new passport at least 125 days before departure. We require a copy of your passport no later than 121 days prior to departure to finalize your cruise arrangements. If you are not a Canadian citizen you are responsible to ensure you have all documentation required to enter the countries you are visiting and for your return to Canada.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

During walking tours you will likely experience uneven ground, cobblestone streets and various amounts of steps or stairs. For your enjoyment, and in fairness to your fellow passengers, you should be in good physical condition, with the ability to stand for extended periods of time and walk up to two kilometres easily. Should you feel a particular excursion may be too strenuous, you are welcome to forgo the sightseeing tour and rest or explore on your own.

TOUR DOCUMENTS

An extensive set of tour documents will be sent approximately 15-25 days prior to departure. Please notify our office in writing if you require any information in advance of this date.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE

Typically airlines allow you to check one suitcase free of charge but this is subject to change. In order to avoid excess baggage fees, the dimensions of your suitcase should not exceed 60" (i.e. 30" length + 20" height + 10" width) and the weight should not exceed 23 kgs. Rostad Tours accepts no

responsibility for the loss of, or damage to, any baggage or any tour member's personal belongings.

ITINERARY VARIATIONS

The cruise operator, Viking River Cruises, Inc reserves the right to withdraw and/or cancel a tour or to make changes in the itinerary whenever, in its sole judgment, conditions warrant it. RESPONSIBILITY




