## **Water Princess Lesson Plan**

### K-2: Questions to check for understanding

(English: With guidance and support from adults, recall information from experiences or gather information from provided sources to answer a question.)


#### **Learning Targets**

- 1. I will have awareness of the water crisis.
- 2. I will answer questions about a story.
- 3. I will predict what could happen in a story.

#### Procedure

- 1. Show students where Burkina Faso is on the map! It is good for them to understand the place-based story.
- 2. Have them predict what they think will happen in the story, based on the title and cover.
- 3. If you think it would be helpful, have each student take a part in the story: one Gie Gie, Maman, narrator. Read multiple times to give students the chance to participate.
- 4. Go through the questions together, answering them either individually or as a group.
- 5. You can choose to tie in a hands on piece of having students paint a scene from the book!

- 1. Who is Gie Gie?
- 2. Why does she call herself "Princess Gie Gie"? What can she do as a princess?
- 3. What task does she have to do every morning with her Maman?
- 4. How would you pass the time if you had to walk for water every day?
- 5. Finish the story- what solution do you think Gie Gie will come up with?
