// jairus'_daughter_and_the_bleeding_woman //

 41 A man came up, Jairus by name. He was president of the meeting place. He fell at Jesus' feet and begged him to come to his home 42 because his twelve-year-old daughter, his only child, was dying. Jesus went with him, making his way through the pushing, jostling crowd.

⁴³In the crowd that day there was a woman who for twelve years had been afflicted with hemorrhages. She had spent every penny she had on doctors but not one had been able to help her. ⁴⁴She slipped in from behind and touched the edge of Jesus' robe. At that very moment her hemorrhaging stopped.

45 Jesus said, "Who touched me?"

When no one stepped forward, Peter said, "But Master, we've got crowds of people on our hands. Dozens have touched you."

⁴⁶Jesus insisted, "Someone touched me. I felt power discharging from me."

⁴⁷When the woman realized that she couldn't remain hidden, she knelt trembling before him. In front of all the people, she blurted out her story--why she touched him and how at that same moment she was healed .⁴⁸Jesus said, "Daughter, you took a risk trusting me, and now you're healed and whole. Live well, live blessed!"




⁴⁹While he was still talking, someone from the leader's house came up and told him, "Your daughter died. No need now to bother the Teacher." ⁵⁰Jesus overheard and said, "Don't be upset. Just trust me and everything will be all right."

⁵¹Going into the house, he wouldn't let anyone enter with him except Peter, John, James, and the child's parents. ⁵²Everyone was crying and carrying on over her. Jesus said, "Don't cry. She didn't die; she's sleeping." ⁵³They laughed at him. They knew she was dead.

⁵⁴Then Jesus, gripping her hand, called, "My dear child, get up." ⁵⁵She was up in an instant, up and breathing again! He told them to give her something to eat. ⁵⁶Her parents were ecstatic, but Jesus warned them to keep quiet. "Don't tell a soul what happened in this room."

// cleansing_ten_lepers //

¹¹It happened that as he made his way toward Jerusalem, he crossed over the border between Samaria and Galilee. ¹²As he entered a village, ten men, all lepers, met him. They kept their distance ¹³but raised their voices, calling out, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!"

¹⁴Taking a good look at them, he said, "Go, show yourselves to the priests."

They went, and while still on their way, became clean. ¹⁵One of them, when he realized that he was healed, tumed around and came back, shouting his gratitude, glorifying God. ¹⁶He kneeled at Jesus' feet, so grateful. He couldn't thank him enough--and he was a Samaritan.

¹⁷Jesus said, "Were not ten healed? Where are the nine? ¹⁸Can none be found to come back and give glory to God except this outsider?" ¹⁹Then he said to him, "Get up. On your way. Your faith has healed and saved you."

// cleansing_a_leper //

⁴⁰A leper came to him, begging on his knees, "If you want to, you can cleanse me." ⁴¹Deeply moved, Jesus put out his hand, touched him, and said, "I want to. Be clean."

⁴²Then and there the leprosy was gone, his skin smooth and healthy. ⁴³Jesus dismissed him with strict orders: ⁴⁴"Say nothing to anyone. Take the offering for cleansing that Moses prescribed and present yourself to the priest. This will validate your healing to the people."

⁴⁵But as soon as the man was out of earshot, he told everyone he met what had happened, spreading the news all over town. So Jesus kept to out-of-the-way places, no longer able to move freely in and out of the city. But people found him, and came from all over.

Faith

Jesus keeps telling people that it is their "faith" that heals them. Most people probably looked at Jesus as a travelling miracle worker, much like they would have of a travelling magician. Jesus was telling them, however, that this is no trick, it is your "faith", your belief in God that heals you. Jesus' continual message was the kingdom of God, and his hope was that they would accept and live this message by faith in God.

Hope

Every single person who was healed by Jesus (as recorded in the Gospels) had hope. Hope that God, through Jesus, could heal them—return them to wholeness instead of brokenness. Our hope is the same: that God would heal our brokenness and make us whole.

- 4. What did Jesus do for Jairus' daughter? He raised her back to life!
- 5. How many lepers were healed? 10
- 6. How many lepers turned around and thanked Jesus? 1
- 7. What was special about that one leper? He was an outsider
- 8. What did Jesus way healed the one leper? "Your faith has healed and saved you" (Luke 17:19)
