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REMEMBER

Now there are different gifts, but the same Spirit. –1 Corinthians 12:4

READ

Read 1 Corinthians 12:12-31. God made the human body with many unique parts, and each one has a special job. Some of those parts are small and loud (like the mouth), some are big and strong (like the legs), and other important parts are quiet and hidden (like the heart and lungs). But all the parts work together to keep the body healthy.

Similarly, God calls His people the “body of Christ.” That means we are connected, and each of us has a special gift, a job to do to keep the body of Christ strong. Those gifts are different yet valuable. God has given each of us unique talents, and we should work to discover and celebrate both the visible and hidden gifts in each of us!

THINK

1. Think about your body. How does it all work together? Which parts are hidden but important?
2. Ahanu is excited to receive the Heart award. How would you feel if you were given a special award?
3. The bullies said mean words about Ahanu, and that made Joshua sad. Have you seen someone be bullied? How did you feel?
4. In the story, God gave Ahanu the gift of being full of good thoughts about others. How does Ahanu inspire you to be more thoughtful?
5. Ahanu has Down Syndrome. Joshua’s dad reminds us to see the value God placed in every person, including friends like Ahanu who are differently abled in how their bodies work. Why is it important to remember we are all valuable?
