

## "WIN A TRIP TO LOUISIANA!" CONTEST

### OFFICIAL RULES

#### CONTEST DURATION

1. This contest is held by TFO (the "Contest Organizers"). Subject to applicable laws, this regulation governs all aspects of the "Win a Trip to Louisiana!" Contest. The contest is held in Ontario, on the internet, starting January 31, 2018 at 9:00 AM and ending on February 28, 2018 at 11:59 PM (the "Duration of the Contest").

#### ELIGIBILITY

2. This contest is open to all teachers residing in Ontario and aged 18 and plus, excluding employees, representatives and agents of the Contest Organizers, their affiliated companies, their publicity and promotion agencies, as well as any prize, material or services suppliers used during this publicity contest, or any stakeholder directly connected to the contest's organization or members of their immediate family (father, mother, siblings, children), their legal or de facto spouse, and any persons with whom these employees, representatives and agents live.
3. **No purchase necessary.** Participants must fill out the registration form on (<https://concours.idello.org/>) during the Duration of the Contest, which will automatically register the participant to the IDELLO platform. You must fill out the registration form by indicating your first name, surname, and email address. You must then check the box confirming that you have read and accepted the participation rules. Then, click on "PARTICIPATE".
4. In the event that you are already in possession of an IDELLO account, you will have to specify the school to nominate, then click on "PARTICIPATE".
5. For the entire Duration of the Contest, there is a limit of one registration per email address.

#### PRIZE

6. A 4-day trip to Louisiana with a colleague in order to meet local teachers and explore the rich cultural attractions of the cities of Lafayette, Baton Rouge and New Orleans. This trip for two is valued at \$6,000.
7. The prize includes the travel costs, accommodations, meals, compensation equivalent to the necessary substitute days for the winning teacher and their travel companion, as well as a Guide by the Conseil pour le développement du français en Louisiane.

## **DRAWING**

8. On March 5, 2018, at 2:00 PM, a digital drawing will be held at Groupe Média TFO to pick the grand prize winner among all the eligible registrations made during the Duration of the Contest.

## **CHANCES OF WINNING**

9. The chances of winning one (1) prize depend on the number of eligible registrations made during the Duration of the Contest for each school.

## **PRIZE CLAIM**

10. In order to be declared the winner of the grand prize, the selected teacher must:

10.1 be reachable by phone or email no later than March 14, 2018, at the sole discretion of the Contest Organizers. In the event that the selected schools were reached by email, they must reply according to the instructions provided within the email, as necessary.

In the event that a prize notification email is followed by a message claiming that the email could not be delivered, the Contest Organizers can, at their sole discretion, disqualify participants or seek to contact them by phone.

10.2 have correctly answered the math ability question given on the liability waiver and release form (the "Waiver Form") that will be sent by mail or email by the Contest Organizers.

10.3 fill out and sign the Waiver Form declaring that the winner has respected all the conditions established in these rules and return it, by email, to the Contest Organizers so that they receive the Form within three (3) days of its reception;

10.4 on request, and in a timely fashion, provide a piece of personal identification with a photograph.

11. If the selected teacher does not respect the conditions mentioned in these rules or does not accept the prize, the teacher shall be disqualified. In such a case, the Contest Organizers can, at their sole discretion, cancel the prize or perform a new drawing among the teachers registered for the contest of the given week until a teacher is selected and declared the winner.

12. In the weeks following the reception of the properly filled and signed Waiver Form, the Contest Organizers will communicate with the winner to inform him or her of the means by which to claim the prize.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS

13. Validation. Registration forms, claim forms, written participation requests and waiver forms are subject to validation by the Contest Organizers. Any registration form, claim form, written participation request or waiver form that is either incomplete, illegible, mutilated, fraudulent, saved or transmitted too late, which contains an invalid email address or phone number, which does not contain the right answer to the math questions or that is otherwise non-compliant could be rejected and shall not give a right to registration or to the prize.
14. Disqualification. The Contest Organizers reserve the right to disqualify a teacher or cancel a teacher's registration if the teacher participates or attempts to participate in the contest using a method contrary to these rules or in a manner that could be unfair towards other participants (e.g. registrations after the allowed deadline). The guilty school could be declared to the legal authorities with the appropriate jurisdiction.
15. Execution of the Contest. Any attempt to deliberately damage the website for this contest and/or any website connected to the contest, or to tamper with the contest's legitimate execution shall be considered a violation of civil and criminal rights. Should such attempts be made, the Contest Organizers reserve the right to reject the participant's registration and seek to obtain compensation to the full extent of the law.
16. Acceptance of Prize. The grand prize shall be accepted as described in these rules and can by no means be transferred, in full or in part, to another school, substituted for another prize or exchanged in part or in full for money, subject to the following.
17. Substitution of Prize. In the event that the Contest Organizers are unable to provide the prize as described in these rules, they reserve the right to provide a prize of similar nature and equivalent value or, at their sole discretion, the money value of the prize indicated in these rules.
18. Liability Limitation: Usage of the Prize. By participating in this contest, any school selected for a prize shall waive all liability from the Contest Organizers, and any company, business, trust or other legal entity controlled by or linked to them, as well as their publicity or promotion agencies, their employees, their agents and their representatives (the "Beneficiaries") for any damage it may incur by accepting or using the prize.

19. Website Serviceability. The Contest Organizers do not in any way guarantee that the contest's website, or any website connected to it, will be accessible or functional without interruption throughout the Duration of the Contest, or that it will be exempt of errors.

20. Liability Limitation: Contest Functionality. The beneficiaries shall not be held liable for any malfunction of any electronic component, software or line of communication, relating to the loss or absence of a communication network, or relating to any transmission that is defective, incomplete, incomprehensible, or deleted by any computer or network, and that could limit or prevent any person from participating in the contest. Beneficiaries shall also not be held liable for any damages or losses that could have been caused directly or indirectly, in part or in full, by downloading any webpage, any software or other, or by transmitting any information relating to a contest registration.

21. Contest Amendment. Contest Organizers reserve the right, at their sole discretion, to cancel, end, amend or suspend this contest, in part or in full, should an event or human intervention that could alter or influence the administration, safety, impartiality or execution of the contest as established by these rules occur.

22. Prize Limit. In all cases, Contest Organizers cannot be obligated to distribute more prizes or distribute a prize in a manner other than the manner described in these rules.

23. Liability Limitation: Participation in the Contest. By participating or attempting to participate in this contest, all participants shall clear the beneficiaries of any liability for damages they could incur due to their participation or attempt to participate in the contest.

24. Authorization. By participating in this contest, the teacher selected for a prize authorizes the Contest Organizers and their representatives to use, if needed, his or her name, his or her photograph, his or her image, his or her voice, his or her place of residence and/or declaration relating to the prize for publicity reasons, without any form of payment.

25. Communication with Participants. No communication or correspondence shall be exchanged with teachers in the context of this contest other than in the manner described in the contest rules or on the initiative of the Contest Organizers.

26. Personal Information. Personal information collected from participants in the context of this contest shall only be used for the administration of this contest. No communication, commercial or otherwise, that is not linked to this contest shall be sent to participants unless they have otherwise consented to it.

27. Property. Waiver forms and written participation forms are the property of the Contest Organizers and shall in no case be returned to participants.

28. Participant Identification. For the purposes of these rules, a participant is the teacher whose name appears on the registration form and to whom the prize will be given if the teacher is selected and declared the winner.

29. Decision by the Contest Organizers. Any decision by the Contest Organizers or their representatives relating to this contest is final and cannot be appealed in matters relating to jurisdiction.

30. Facebook Platform. This contest is not associated with, managed by or sponsored by Facebook. Any question, complaint or comment regarding the contest must be sent to the Contest Organizers, and not to Facebook. Facebook, as well as all its affiliated companies, administrators, managers, agents and employees, is not responsible for any claim ensuing from or relating to the execution of this contest. However, by participating in this contest, participants accept to respect the terms and conditions regarding usage, contracts, other policies or guidelines governing the Facebook platform and shall waive all liability from the Contest Organizers, and any company, business, trust or other legal entity controlled by or linked to them, as well as their publicity or promotion agencies, their employees, their agents and their representatives for any damage it may incur by using this platform.

31. Paragraph Divisibility. Should a paragraph of these rules be declared or judged illegal, unenforceable or null by a competent jurisdiction, that paragraph shall be considered void, but all other paragraphs that are not concerned shall be applied within the limits allowed by the law.

32. Language. In the event of differences between the French version and the English version of this document, the French version shall prevail.

33. Liability Limitation: Prize Supplier. Any selected participant for a prize shall recognize that, once the prize is awarded, obligations connected to the prize become the responsibility of the service supplier that provides the prize.
