


Finding and using eBooks in the WTS Library

The Westminster Seminary Library's search engine allows you to find all our eBooks via the search box on the Library's home page.



Once you have done a search, look for a link that indicates full text availability. The link text will vary.



TIP: eBooks can be read online but if you want to download a copy, you will need <u>Adobe Digital Editions</u> downloaded and authorized on your computer or device. Depending on publisher rights, you may also need to create accounts to sign in to the platform where the eBooks is hosted. Also note that for the ATLA eBook lending website, you will need to login as a WTS user with your last name and WTS ID number. The first letter of your last name must be capitalised

Authorizing your computer:

The first time you launch Adobe Digital Editions you will be prompted to authorize your computer or device with an Adobe ID. If you don't already have an Adobe ID, register for free at accounts.adobe.com, and then enter your Adobe ID login into Adobe Digital Editions. You can authorize any combination of up to 6 computers and devices.

Returning an eBook before the due date:

In Adobe Digital Editions, right-click on the eBook and choose "Return Borrowed Item".

Please note that eBooks may only be downloaded on your personal computer or device and are not available for downloading at public computers in the WTS Library.
