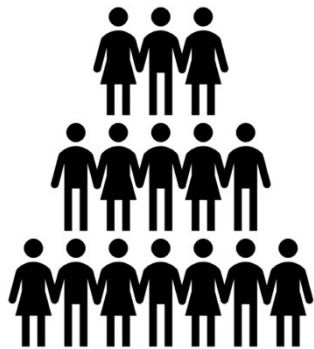
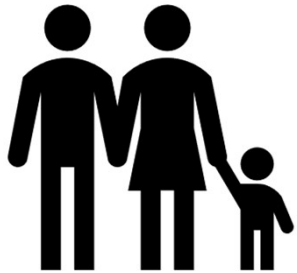

Why do the PIT & HIC Matter?

What is the Point-in-Time Count?



Point In Time (PIT) Count

- Counts and collects demographic information on sheltered and unsheltered persons experiencing homelessness
- Conducted on a single night at the end of January

Sheltered Count

- Emergency Shelter (ES)
- Safe Haven (SH)
- Transitional Housing (TH)

Unsheltered (UN) count

- Individuals staying on the streets, encampments, in their car, or other places not intended as housing

PIT: What data is collected

The PIT focuses on demographic information on homeless persons. This includes:

Age

Gender

Race

Ethnicity

Veteran Status

Chronic Status

- Homeless History
- Disabling Conditions

Domestic Violence history

What is the Housing Inventory Count?

Housing Inventory Count (HIC)

- Point-in-time inventory of providers within a Continuum of Care that provide beds and units dedicated to persons who are homeless.
- HIC data is collected for a single night, typically at the end of January.

The following project types are included:

- Emergency Shelter (ES)
- Safe Haven (SH)
- Transitional Housing (TH)
- Rapid Rehousing (RRH)
- Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH)
- Other Permanent Housing (OPH)

HIC: What data is collected

The HIC focuses on Project Descriptor Data Elements. This includes:

Agency and Project names

Housing Type and Target Population

Operating Dates

Location information

Funding information

Bed Inventory

The HIC also asks for number of persons served.

Every project reports on
two types of information

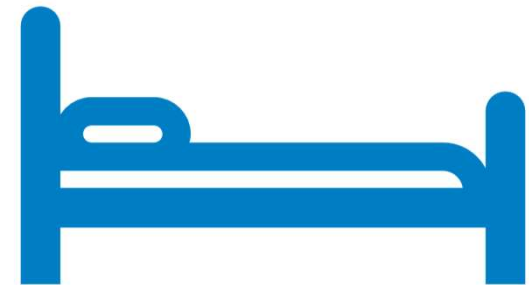

PIT HIC night

Wednesday night into Thursday morning

By 2/7

HMIS projects – ICA takes lead

SysAdmins send reports to agency for DQ and verification of clients served

Set up time for reviewing project info & bed inventory

Non-HMIS projects – Agencies take lead

Must submit Persons Served data to ICA

By 2/29

All data is complete and accurate

Persons Served data has been corrected and verified

SysAdmins, with agencies, have completed project info & bed inventory

SysAdmins have updated HMIS with PDDE info

By Mid-March

PIT Aggregation complete

Preliminary data is compiled for presentation to CoCs

HIC upload process to HDX 2.0

Early/Mid-April

Final Submission
