Facilitator Guide, Checklist & Logbook

The addition of a Facilitator Guide, and changes to practical training, and logbook will improve preparation for trainees' practical assessments.

The Facilitator Guide assists current airside drivers during training duties.

The logbook document updates include maximum hour logging, extra information, and a practical training document (former checklist).
