## 1. Introduction to the Online Standards Development (OSD) platform?

ISO and IEC are developing a new <u>Online Standards Development (OSD)</u> platform which aims at providing the technical community with a unique and harmonized platform for online standards development, from the preparatory stage through to publication.

The platform is currently available for the preparatory and committee stage in pilot mode.

## 2. Introduction to the OSD Member Commenting process

Member commenting through Committee stage in the OSD has been designed to **ease your national voting processes** when it comes to International Standards through:

- improved **commenting** features for national experts
- facilitated consensus building with improve consolidation and management of national comments for voters
- simplified submission of national comments by voters


### 3. As voter what do I need to do?

Once you have taken note of the information provided in the <u>Member Commenting – Getting</u> <u>started</u> article, you need to consult with your NSB and choose between option A or B and follow the step by step instructions:


- Option A: take full advantage of the new OSD platform features to gather national comments, consolidate comments and submit comments to ISO - Option A summary of actions for voters
- Option B: if you Continue to gather national comments using the current ISO/IEC commenting template and upload your consolidated commenting file into the OSD platform.
