

Step 1: Disengage clutch cable from lifter arm

Loosen clutch cable by using the lock nut beside the clutch cable bracket. Pull cable out of clutch lifter arm.



Step 2: Install gaiter and reattach clutch cable

Use 4mm wrench to remove stock clutch cable bracket. Use 4mm wrench to install BC Clutch Cable Bracket.



Step 3: Install BC Clutch Cable Bracket

Run clutch cable through BC Clutch Cable Bracket. Reattach clutch cable to clutch arm. Tighten clutch cable using locknut to proper tension.
