For all meals, activities and care plans/medication information:

Alexa, ask VoiceFriend.

For meals:

Alexa, ask VoiceFriend ...

What are my meals?

What's for breakfast?

What's for lunch?

What's for dinner?

For activities/events:

Alexa, ask VoiceFriend ...

What are my activities?

What are my events?

For care plans/medications:

Alexa, ask VoiceFriend ...

What are my medications?

What are my care plans?

What medications do I take?

When do I take my medications?

For wellness/safety checks:

Alexa, tell VoiceFriend ...

I'm okay.

To request assistance from the staff on duty: *Alexa, tell StaffAlert.*
