
Broadbean & Facebook

Broadbean Technology has developed an App to allow recruiters to post jobs to their company Facebook page.

This appears as an App on the page which can be renamed and rebranded and also allows you to engage with potential hires by posting jobs to the wall of your page.

The App itself holds all posted jobs and allows candidates to search your live vacancies with an easy filter for Location, Industry, Job Type and a salary slider







Getting started

Firstly, you will need to log in to Facebook. This should be your personal account as the business page needs to be linked to a personal license.

Go to your business page and you should see the admin bar at the top of the page with the Settings tab on the top right hand side.


If you do not see this panel, you are not listed as an admin for that page and you would need to get the login details from the creator or another admin. Alternatively, you can ask the page creator to make you a Page Admin. You must first have liked this page from your personal account for this to happen.

Under Settings, you will find an option for Page Roles. This is where the creator of the page can add you as an Admin or if you are the creator, you can assign roles to people who have liked the page.

You must be listed as an Admin to be able to grant permission for the App to use your page

NB. None of your personal details will be shown on your business page.








In a separate tab, login to your Broadbean account as superadmin and go to the Job Boards tab. In the Search boards field, search for Facebook and then click on the first Facebook option to be taken to the subscription details page.

You can choose whether you wish to add the page at Company level or if you want to add it to just a specific office, team or user.



Once you have decided which level to activate the subscription at, you need to click on Manage Page and this will then redirect you to the Facebook Page Manager.

(This is found next to the status access token field as shown here)






The Facebook Page Manager will now load and you first need to add the App to your page. You do this by clicking on the Click Here hyperlink. This will prompt Facebook to display a list of the pages that you manager

Select your page from the drop down menu. If you are the admin of multiple pages and you wish to set these up as well, make sure that you select all of the pages you wish to use.

You can then click on Add Page Tab. This will automatically add the tab to each of the pages you have selected.

The page will not reload so it may not seem like anything has happened but the update to your page is done behind the scenes.







You are now back on the Facebook Page Manager and now you can set up the Post as Status option.


This allows the job posts to appear on the wall of your page so that anyone who has liked your page will see the job in their Facebook Timeline.

Exactly the same as the Add Tab option, you click on the Click Here Hyperlink.


You may be asked to authorise the App. This just means that you allow the Broadbean App to post adverts to your company page. Click on Go to App.

Facebook will then ask you to allow Broadbean to login as the pages you have selected and allow the app to post on your behalf. Again, none of your personal information is shared anywhere.

Click Allow to complete the process and then you will be shown a list of the pages that you can set up for Post as Status









Once you have allowed the app, you will be taken back to your page manager and you will see the logos of the Facebook pages you can configure.

You can then click on the logo of the page you wish to add and this will then redirect back to your subscriptions within Broadbean and the details that you need to post will now be populated against the specific level you chose.

If you have multiple pages, click on Show as text below your company logo, as can be seen above, and this will then show you all of your page ID's and access tokens

You will then need to copy these to a notepad and then copy and paste in the required fields on the subscriptions page. Click on Return to Subscriptions to access this page.


Once you land back on your subscriptions page, you now need to tick the Active box on the left hand side to enable the feed. You will also be able to choose which method you want to use for the status updates:

Never – will not send a status with your job to the Facebook wall

Short – will send job title, industry, job type, salary & location and a brief description of the job to the wall

Full – will send the full job description to the wall

Optional – will give users the choice of the above on the last stage of job posting





Once you have completed the steps, click Save at the bottom of the page and this will now have added Facebook to your account and enabled wall posting. Facebook will now appear as a job board channel when selecting boards to post to.




Editing your Facebook App


You are able to change the logo and name of the App on your page. To do so, you will need to head back to the Settings tab on your Facebook page and this time choose the Apps option.

Under the AdCourier App, there is an Edit Settings link and you will need to click here to be able to update your App.

You now have the option to update the logo of the Broadbean App and also rename the tab so that it fits in with your company Branding. Simply click on Change to be able to amend the logo of the page and you will be given information regarding image sizes and how to upload.

Type in the Custom tab name you wish to use and click Save and then OK.












Broadbean & Twitter

Broadbean Technology has developed an App to allow recruiters to post jobs to their company Twitter feed.

Each job is posted with #job and you are also able to default your own hashtag to allow candidates to find your jobs quicker

This appears as a tweet on the timeline which gives basic information regarding a new job and then provides a tiny URL to a page that hosts your jobs and allows candidates to apply for your vacancies.







Getting Started

In the same way as the Facebook set up, you will first need to be logged in to your Broadbean account as superadmin. Go to the Job Boards tab and in the Search boards field, search for Twitter and then click on the first Twitter option to be taken to the subscription details page.


You can again choose whether you wish to add the page at Company level or if you want to add it to just a specific office, team or user.

This time, you will need to click on the Request Key link which sits between the Access Secret and Twitter Hash Tag fields.

Twitter will ask you to authorise AdCourier to use your account. It will also let you know what the application can access. If you are not already logged into the Twitter feed that you wish to post to then you will be taken to the login page first.

You can see the account you are logged into by hovering over the icon in the top right hand corner of the page, so you can make sure it is the correct feed. Once you authorise the App, you will be taken back into Broadbean.







The Access Token and Access Secret will now be populated for you. These are the only details you need in order to post to your Twitter account.

You can then tick the Active box to enable the posting to the feed.


There is also a field called Twitter Hash Tag. This allows you to default a hash tag on all jobs posted by the business. These will appear on each tweet at the end of the tiny URL that holds your job.

There is a limit as to how many characters can be used in hash tags. You can have a **maximum of 30 characters**. This can either be one long hash tag

e.g #broadbeantechnologyjobs **or** a few smaller tags

e.g #broadbean #technology.

Each new tag must be separated with a space and '#' counts as one character as do any spaces

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There is also an option to post to a feed called Twitter (Personal). This gives you the ability to post to two separate Twitter accounts at once i.e. the company account and the users personal Twitter account.

To activate this, follow exactly the same process as previously outlined but choose the Twitter (Personal) option from the job board dropdown list.

This will then appear as another posting channel on your job board selection page.
