Now, use this as an exercise in hearing and following the voice of God.

Remember that following the voice of God is never easy. In fact, it can be down right scary in the beginning when you are still learning to believe that you are truly hearing from Him.

If you have to, start off with the smallest thing on the list, and then slowly work your way up to things that are a bit harder to let go of. As you release one thing, pray and tell God you are doing this in an effort to be obedient to Him. Ask Him for confirmation that you are truly in His will. As you see the positive effects of following Him in the small things, you will have more faith to release the larger things on the list to Him as well.
