Reading and studying the great stories of the Bible, the accounts of God's amazing love, provision, and protection, is something we do all the time in the Church. But digging deeper into the intricacies of Hebrew traditions—including the Feasts of the Lord—provides even more reminders and awareness of the Lord's presence and His blessings.</p> <p>Some of the benefits of in-depth studying of the feasts and festivals commanded and ordained in the Old Testament are: a better understanding of the Bible, the rediscovery of the Jewish roots of Christianity, a fuller comprehension of God's plan of redemption, a renewed passion for Jesus, greater insights into God's prophecies regarding the Messiah—Jesus, and spiritual growth and bonding among our sisters in Christ. We celebrate the feast of communion when we partake of the Lord's Supper every Sunday morning!</p> <p>We study each feast for three weeks, and then on the third week, we enjoy eating some of the festival foods. You are invited to come and enjoy the fellowship as we learn more about God's Word. **The Right Place at the Right Time**

In Jesus, disciples have peace and good cheer (John 14:1; 16:33). God's blessings have often been restricted to specific locations:

- The tree of life was in the garden of Eden. When Adam and Eve were driven from there, they had no access to its blessings (Genesis 3:24).
- God offered salvation from the flood in the ark. All who were not in it perished (Genesis 3:24).
- When the firstborn of every family in Egypt faced the plague of death, God provided safety in houses where the Passover lamb's blood was on the door posts and the lintel (Exodus 12).
- Rahab was saved in Jericho as long as she remained in her house (Joshua 2).
- Paul told those in a storm on his prison ship: "Unless these men stay in the ship, you cannot be saved" (Acts 27:31).
- Peace, spiritual prosperity, and safety are where God placed them—in the church (Ephesians 1:3; 3:21; Psalm 122:7).
- Being in Christ is synonymous with being a member of His church (Galatians 3:26-27; Ephesians 1:22-23; 4:4).

Some of the blessings found "in Christ" (a phrase Paul used 169 times) include the following:

**Redemption** (Romans 3:24; Colossians 1:14).

**Peace** (Romans 5:1).

**Joy** (Romans 5:11).

**Grace** (Romans 5:17).

**Abundant life** (Romans 6:11).

**Eternal life** (Romans 6:22; Ephesians 1:3-13; John 5:11).

**Newness of life** (Romans 6:4) "Walk by faith, not by sight" (2 Corinthians 5:7).

**Forgiveness** (Ephesians 1:7).

**Salvation** (2 Timothy 2:10; Acts 4:12); John 14:6).

Since all spiritual blessings are in Christ, and none outside of Him, to receive them, we must be in Him. How does one get into Christ? Several scriptures answer that question, and they all say the same thing:

1. Hearing the gospel (Romans 10:13-14).
2. Believing it (Hebrews 11:6).
3. Repenting of sins (Acts 17:30; Luke 13:3).
4. Confessing Christ (Matthew 10:32-33; Romans 10:10).
5. Baptism—brought into Christ (Galatians 3:27; Romans 6:3; 1 Corinthians 12:13).



If you have friends who might benefit, please let them know about this class as well. **We will meet on the following Saturdays from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon: December 13, March 14, and June 13.**

So many people in the world have experienced significant losses in their lives, so we're thankful to be able to offer this GriefShare Ministry. It is organized around a thirteen-week small-group program where participants meet together for around two hours each week and watch professionally-designed videos featuring professional grief counselors and also people who are grieving. These presentations are coupled with discussions that are designed to internalize what participants learn in the videos.
