The Game: Johns Hopkins (11-1) welcomes RPI (10-1) to Homewood Field for one of four NCAA Division III Quarterfinal games being played this weekend. Kickoff in the first-ever meeting between the two teams is set for 12 pm on Saturday, December 1.

A Look Back: Johns Hopkins made it 10 straight in the win column as the Blue Jays topped sixth-ranked and previously unbeaten Frostburg St., 58-27, in the second round of the NCAA Playoffs last Saturday in Frostburg.

Poll Position: Johns Hopkins is ranked 13th in the AFCA Division III Poll. Dating back to the start of the 2012 season, Johns Hopkins has now appeared in the top 25 of the AFCA Poll 77 times in 79 weeks.

In addition to the #13 ranking from the AFCA, Johns Hopkins is also ranked 14th in the D3football.com Poll. Dating back to the start of the 2012 season, the Blue Jays have now appeared in the top 25 of the D3football.com poll 82 times in 90 weeks.

Johns Hopkins also ranked second in the final official NCAA South Region rankings.

Oh Captain, My Captain: Johns Hopkins will be led this season by co-captains **Michael Curry, Mike Kalanik, Luke McFadden** and **Addison Quinones**.

State of Affairs: The 96-man Johns Hopkins football team includes players from 22 different states.

Scouting the Engineers

RPI Quickly: RPI (10-1) comes to Home-wood Field for the NCAA Quarterfinals fresh off a 21-13 victory at then third-ranked and previously unbeaten Brockport.

Defense Wins Championships: Johns Hopkins will face one of the top defensive units in the nation this week. The Engineers have allowed an average of just 16.5 points per game, have held the opposition to 14 points or less six times and have allowed a total of just 27 points in two playoff games.

In addition, RPI is allowing an average of just 3.3 yards per rushing attempt, has forced 30 turnovers (19 INTs, 11 FR) and opponents have converted just 36.7% 3rd-down chances.

Linebacker **Jack Hoggard** headlines the unit as he has a team-high 108 tackles, including 5.5 for losses, and also counts eight PBUs to his credit.

Three other players - **John Sadak**, **Jack Fallon** and **Luke Watanabe** - all have at least 60 tackles on the year and Sadak and Watanabe have combined for eight of RPI's 19 interceptions.

Marinopoulos Directs Balanced Offense: Quarterback **George Marinopoulos** directs an efficient, balanced offense for the Engineers. He has thrown for 2,235 yards and 16 touchdowns and spreads the ball around well as nine different players have at least 10 receptions on the year.

Keaton Ackermann (33-484-5) and **Conor Davies** (30-275-2) are Marinopoulos's top targets in a pass game that accounts for better than 205 yards per game.

Nick Cella has been the work-horse in the backfield throughout the season as he has rushed for a team-high 832 yards and seven TDs. His 832 yards are nearly half the team's total of 1,681 rushing yards this season.

Notes of Interest: The Engineers have allowed just 11 points in the first quarter this season • **Sanjay Krishnan** has hit 12 field goals on the year • RPI is 5-0 on the road this season and none of those five opponents scored more than 20 points against the Engineers.

How They Got Here: Johns Hopkins earned the Centennial Conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Playoffs (a Pool A bid) and advanced to the quarterfinals with a 49-0 opening-round win over MIT and a 58-27 win over Frostburg St. in the second round.

RPI earned the Liberty League's automatic bid to the NCAA Playoffs (also a Pool A bid) and topped Husson, 38-14, and third-ranked Brockport, 21-13, in its two playoff games.

Did You Know: Sixth-ranked Frostburg St., which Johns Hopkins defeated 58-27 in the second round of the NCAA Playoffs, is the highest-ranked team Johns Hopkins has ever beaten in football. Previously, the highest-ranked team Johns Hopkins had ever beaten was then ninth-ranked McDaniel in 2001 (21-14).

Playoff Bound: Johns Hopkins is making its eighth straight trip to the NCAAs, its ninth in 10 years and 10th overall. All 10 appearances have come since 2005.

A Program Second ... and First: Johns Hopkins is making its second all-time appearance in the NCAA Quarterfinals. The Blue Jays' previous appearance came in 2009, when JHU fell to Wesley, 12-0, in the South Region title game (QF).

This week's game against RPI is also a first. This is the first time Johns Hopkins has ever hosted a game this deep in the playoffs.

Historically Speaking: Johns Hopkins improved to 12-10 overall in the post-season with last week's win against Frostburg. The Blue Jays are now 8-9 in the NCAA Playoffs and 4-1 in ECAC Bowl Games.

Third Longest Streak: Johns Hopkins' eight consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament rank as the third-longest active streak in the nation. Only Mount Union (27) and Mary Hardin-Baylor (17) have currently made more consecutive appearances than Johns Hopkins.

What's Next: The winner of the Johns Hopkins-RPI quarterfinal game will play the winner of the quarterfinal game between Mount Union and Muhlenberg. That semifinal game will be played on Saturday, December 8 at a time and location to be announced on Sunday, December 2. The semifinal games in the NCAA Division III Playoffs will air on ESPN3.

Centennial Conference Champions: Johns Hopkins claimed its record 14th Centennial Conference title this season with all 14 championships coming since 2002. JHU's 14 CC titles are four more than Muhlenberg, which shared the title with the Blue Jays this season, has earned.

Centennial Strong: Johns Hopkins and Muhlenberg will both play in this week's NCAA

All-Centennial Jays

The Johns Hopkins football team was well represented on the 2018 All-Centennial Football Team, which was announced on November 13. The Blue Jays placed 14 players on the team, including nine first team picks, three second team selections and a pair of honorable mention honorees

In addition, junior quarterback **David Tammaro** was named the Centennial Offensive Player of the Year and freshman linebacker **Robert Fletcher** grabbed Rookie of the Year honors.

10 in a Row: Johns Hopkins ran its winning streak to 10 games with last week's 58-27 win at sixth-ranked Frostburg St.

This marks the eighth time since **Jim Margraff** took over as the head coach at Johns Hopkins (1990) that the Blue Jays have had a winning streak of 10 games or longer; six of those eight have come since 2010.

Prior to Margraff's arrival, Johns Hopkins had never won more than seven games in a row (in one season or even bridging two seasons).

Margraff Holds State Record: Johns Hopkins head coach **Jim Margraff** became the winningest college football coach in Maryland state history with a 42-14 win at Ursinus late in the 2014 season as that gave him 175 career victories, a mark he upped to 220 with last week's win against Frostburg St.

Margraff now sports a career record of 220-88-3 (.712) entering this week's NCAA Quarterfinal game against RPI.

Blue Jays Break Scoring Record: Johns Hopkins' 58-point outburst against Frostburg St. last week pushed the Blue Jays' season scoring total to 584 points, a mark that breaks the previous school record of 548 points in 2015 (12 games).

The 2015 and 2018 seasons are the only two seasons in school history in which Johns Hopkins has scored 500 or more points.

Among the National Leaders: Entering this week's game against RPI, Johns Hopkins ranks first in the nation in total offense (568.0), fourth in passing offense (345.2) and fourth in scoring offense (48.7). The Blue Jays also rank seventh in third-down percentage (.507) and the 325 first downs JHU has accumulated are the most of any team in the nation.

A Special Senior Class

This year's senior class will go down as one of the most accomplished in program history. Below is a look at some of their collective team achievements since arriving in 2015:



- JHU has won four Centennial Conference titles and appeared in the NCAA Playoffs in each of their four seasons.

- The Blue Jays have compiled a record of 42-5 since the current seniors arrived. The 42 wins are tied for the second-most in school history by one class.

- Johns Hopkins posted a 38-2 regular season record since the start of the 2015 season.

- The Blue Jays did not lose a regular season home game during their career.

Six in 132, Nine in 23: In the first 132 seasons of Johns Hopkins football, the Blue Jays had six games of 600+ yards of total offense. In the last 23 games, the Blue Jays have topped the 600-yard mark nine times.

Record-Breaking: Johns Hopkins extended its school single-season record of 600-yard games to six with a 647-yard outburst against Frostburg St. in the second round of the NCAA Playoffs. The Blue Jays had never previously had more than three 600-yard games in one season prior to this year.

Best Passing Season in School History: Johns Hopkins quarterbacks have combined to throw for 4,142 yards in 12 games this season. The 4,142 yards rank as the highest single-season total in school history; the previous record of 4,106 yards was set in 12 games in 2016.

Blue Jays Break Touchdown Record: With seven touchdowns in the 49-0 win against MIT in the first round of the playoffs and eight more last week at Frostburg St., Johns Hopkins has now scored 83 touchdowns on the year. That breaks the previous school single-season record of 75, which was set in 2015.

Balanced Scoring: Johns Hopkins' 83 touchdowns this season are split nearly even as the Blue Jays count 42 rushing touchdowns and 38 passing touchdowns on the year (JHU also scored once each on a blocked punt return, interception and fumble return). Only once previously (2015) had JHU scored 35 or more touchdowns on the ground and through the air (the 2015 team had 38 rushing TDs and 36 passing TDs).

More, Firsts and Records: In addition to the records noted above, the Blue Jays have left a mark in a number of other places in the record book. Below are several additional notes of interest about the Blue Jay offense:

- The Blue Jays rolled up 428 yards passing and 252 yards rushing in the win at Moravian. That marked the first time in school history that the Blue Jays have totaled more than 400 yards passing and 250 yards rushing in the same game. After never having turned the 400/250 trick in 133 seasons (plus two games), the Blue Jays did it twice in three weeks as they followed up the effort at Moravian with a 405-yard passing, 262-yard rushing performance against Ursinus.

- The 33 points Johns Hopkins scored in the second quarter and the 46 points the Blue Jays rolled up in the first half against Dickinson are the second best totals in a quarter and half in school history.

- JHU led Dickinson 46-0 at the half on September 22. The 46-point halftime margin is the largest in school history. Previously, the largest lead the Blue Jays held at halftime was 42 (49-7 lead at McDaniel in 2017).

- Johns Hopkins has scored 40 or more points 10 times this season; that breaks the previous school record of nine (2016).

Big Plays: Through 12 games, the Johns Hopkins offense has 100 plays of 20 yards or longer (an average of 8.3 such plays per game) and 253 plays of 10 yards or longer (21.1 such plays per game). Note that this includes offensive plays only (rushing and passing plays).

It's Been a While - Part I: The shutout for the Blue Jays in the 56-0 win at Juniata on November 3 was the first road shutout for Johns Hopkins since October 13, 2012, when JHU topped Dickinson, 49-0.

It's Been a While - Part II: The 56-0 win at Juniata was JHU's largest shutout victory since September 19, 1997, when the Blue Jays topped Swarthmore 73-0.

Twice in Three Weeks: Johns Hopkins notched its second shutout of the season with the 49-0 win against MIT in the first round of the NCAA Playoffs. That gives the Blue Jays two shutouts in the same season for the first time since 2011.

Seven or Less Under Rehring: Since Mickey Rehring took over as the Blue Jay defensive coordinator in 2013, Johns Hopkins has held the opposition to seven points or less 16 times - including the three-point performance by Moravian on September 15, the six-point effort by Ursinus a week later, the shutout at Juniata on November 3 and the shutout against MIT in the first round of the playoffs.

109 in 10: After allowing an average of 34 points per game in the first two games, the Blue Jay defense has worked its way into form and has allowed a total of just 109 points in the last 10 games - all Blue Jay victories.

Defense Fuels Win Over Muhlenberg: The Johns Hopkins defense forced six turnovers and totaled three sacks and 11 pass breakups to fuel the 27-16 victory over 22nd-ranked Muhlenberg. The Blue Jays last forced six or more turnovers in 2010 and the 11 pass breakups are the most by Johns Hopkins since the Jays had 11 in a win against McDaniel in 2005. Hopkins held the Mules 21 points and more than 120 yards below their season averages entering the game.

Sack Party: The Johns Hopkins defense has totaled 37 sacks on the year, including 27 in the last seven games. With six sacks at Franklin & Marshall and five at Gettysburg, the Blue Jays had five or more sacks in back-to-back games for the first time since notching six against Randolph-Macon and five against Susquehanna early in the 2012 season. The Blue Jays added three in the win against Muhlenberg, six at Juniata, four against McDaniel, one against MIT and two against Frostburg. St.

Walters Breaks TD Records: Senior running back **Stuart Walters** tied the Johns Hopkins record for career touchdowns with his 51st in the 27-16 win over Muhlenberg and took the top spot to himself with three in the regular-season-ending win against McDaniel. He added one rushing touchdown against MIT to take over the top spot on JHU's career rushing touchdowns list as well (45).

PK Enters the Record Book - Part I: Junior defensive back **Patrick Kelly** intercepted a Gettysburg pass on the last play of the game and returned it 90 yards before being tackled. The 90-yard interception return is the longest in school history - 10 yards longer than **Les Matthews'** 80-yard return against then Western Maryland (McDaniel) on November 18, 1972.

PK Enters the Record Book - Part II: Not only did **Patrick Kelly** set a Johns Hopkins record with a 90-yard interception return at Gettysburg, he also became the first player in school history with two different types of 90+ yard plays. Kelly had a 95-yard kickoff return for a touchdown against Gettysburg last season and added the 90-yard INT return this season.

The only other player in school history with two 90-yard plays is **Harrison Bernstein**, who had kickoff returns of 95 and 92 yards during his career from 1996-99.

Block Party: Freshman **Robert Fletcher** needed exactly three minutes to impact the first game of his career as he blocked a Randolph-Macon punt that was returned 32 yards for a touchdown by senior **Tyler Messinger**. The blocked punt return for a touchdown was the first for Johns Hopkins since **Adam Schweyer** took one back 36 yards for a score against Juniata on October 30, 2010.

Fletcher was back at it against Dickinson as he partially blocked a first-quarter Red Devil punt that led to a Johns Hopkins touchdown and also got a piece of Franklin & Marshall's first punt to give him three blocks on the year; he is tied for 12th in the nation with his three blocked kicks.

More Blocks: Johns Hopkins has blocked a total of eight kicks on the year. That ties the Blue Jays for seventh in the nation entering this week's game against RPI.

Pick Six: Sophomore **Macauley Kilbane** scored the second of four, fourth-quarter touchdowns for the Blue Jays in the season-opener against Randolph-Macon as he returned an interception 34 yards for a score with 13:20 remaining.

The interception return for a score was the first for the Blue Jays since **Dan Johnson's** 23-yard return for a touchdown against F&M on November 7, 2013.

Because You'll Ask - Part I: For the record, the last time Johns Hopkins scored a touchdown on offense, defense and special teams - prior to turning the trick in the season-opener against Randolph-Macon - was on November 10, 2007, when **Richard Hill** returned the opening kickoff 90 yards for a touchdown, **Adam Winter** returned an interception 12 yards for a score and the Blue Jay offense scored a pair of touchdowns in a 31-3 win at McDaniel.

Because You'll Ask - Part II: With the three returns for touchdowns this season (FR, INT, Blocked PR), Johns Hopkins has now scored 49 touchdowns on returns since head coach **Jim Margraff** took over in 1990 (see chart to right for complete list).

GAME 13 - RPI at JOHNS HOPKINS

Record-Tying: Senior punter **Brandon Hong-Dominguez** tied the Johns Hopkins record for the longest punt in school history with a 75-yard bomb late in the fourth quarter against Dickinson. It is just the fifth 70+ yard punt in school history and tied **Ben Scott's** school record (vs. Rochester / 2005).

At Home at Homewood: Johns Hopkins has parlayed its home field advantage into victories in recent years. In fact, the Blue Jays are 49-5 (.907) in the home blacks since the start of the 2010 season.

Number Four: Johns Hopkins boasts a 63-7 record since the start of the 2013 season. The Blue Jays' .900 winning percentage over that time ranks fourth among Division III teams. In order, the top five teams in the nation in winning percentage since the start of the 2013 season (with records included):

61 Under to 61 Over: Johns Hopkins head coach **Jim Margraff** inherited a program with an all-time record that was 61 games **UNDER** .500 when he arrived (334-395-56). With the win against Juniata on November 4, 2017, Johns Hopkins moved its all-time record to 61 games **OVER** .500. Entering this week's game against RPI, Johns Hopkins has an all-time record of 554-483-59 (+71).

Close Calls: Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of seven games. Those seven losses have come by five, three, five, seven, four, three and two points (including playoff games). Translation ... JHU has lost seven games in 5+ seasons by a total of 29 points.

On a Roll: Johns Hopkins is 81-3 in its last 84 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season and 87-10 in its last 97 games overall since late in the 2010 season.

Sustained Success: Since the start of the 2002 season, the Blue Jays sport a 154-38 (.802) record. Taking it back farther, the Blue Jays are 160-41 (.796) since the start of the 2001 season and 165-46 (.782) since the beginning of the 2000 season.

It's All Academic

The Johns Hopkins football team dominated the 2018 CoSIDA Academic All-District II Football Team when it was announced on November 15. Johns Hopkins' eight selections were tied for the most in the nation among Division III schools (Carnegie Mellon).

This is the 10th consecutive year that the Johns Hopkins football program has produced six or more Academic All-District selections and pushes the Blue Jays' total to 108 Academic All-District selections in the last 16 years and 134 selections since 1991.

During JHU's current 10-year run at the top of the Centennial Conference the Blue Jays have now produced 79 Academic All-District players.

To be eligible for CoSIDA Academic All-District honors, a student-athlete must have at least a 3.30 cumulative GPA, be a sophomore or above and a starter or significant reserve.
