The Game: Johns Hopkins (12-1) heads to Ohio to take on top-ranked Mount Union (13-0) in the NCAA Semifinals. Kickoff from Mount Union Stadium is set for 12 pm on Saturday, December 8. This week's game will air live on ESPN3 (espn3.com).

A Look Back: Johns Hopkins made it 11 straight in the win column as the Blue Jays topped 23rd-ranked RPI, 37-14, in the NCAA Quarterfinals last Saturday at Homewood Field.

Poll Position: Johns Hopkins is ranked 13th in the AFCA Division III Poll. Dating back to the start of the 2012 season, Johns Hopkins has now appeared in the top 25 of the AFCA Poll 77 times in 79 weeks.

In addition to the #13 ranking from the AFCA, Johns Hopkins is also ranked 14th in the D3football.com Poll. Dating back to the start of the 2012 season, the Blue Jays have now appeared in the top 25 of the D3football.com poll 82 times in 90 weeks.

Johns Hopkins also ranked second in the final official NCAA South Region rankings.

Oh Captain, My Captain: Johns Hopkins will be led this season by co-captains **Michael Curry, Mike Kalanik, Luke McFadden and Addison Quinones.**

State of Affairs: The 96-man Johns Hopkins football team includes players from 22 different states.

Scouting the Purple Raiders

Mount Union Quickly: Top-ranked and unbeaten Mount Union welcomes Johns Hopkins to Mount Union Stadium for the NCAA Semifinals riding a 28-game winning streak.

NCAA Pedigree: The Purple Raiders are making their 24th consecutive appearance in the NCAA Semifinals and looking for their 21st trip to the Stagg Bowl since 1993. Mount Union owns a record 13 NCAA Championships, including last season's. The 'Raiders are 102-16 all-time in the NCAA Playoffs.

Explosive on Offense: Mount Union enters this week's game averaging 52.9 points and 461.5 yards per game. The Purple Raiders have scored 49 or more points 11 times in 13 games.

Junior quarterback **D'Angelo Fulford** directs the high-powered attack and has thrown for 2,433 yards and 35 touchdowns against just two interceptions; he has also rushed for 392 yards and four scores.

Fulford's top three targets - **Jared Ruth, Justin Hill and Luke Herrington** - have combined for 130 receptions for 2,238 yards and 36 touchdowns on the year.

Sophomore **Josh Petrucci** is one of the top running backs in the nation and provides balance to the unit. He counts 1,364 yards and 19 touchdowns to his credit.

The Nation's Top Defense: While the offense grabs attention, the Purple Raider defense is, as usual, perhaps the best in the nation. Mount Union is allowing just 10.8 points and 247.5 yards per game and 10 of 13 opponents have been held to 14 points or less.

Mitch O'Hara (73), **Trey Williams** (72) and **Danny Robinson** (66) top the tackle charts and shutdown cornerback **Louis Berry** has returned four of his five interceptions and two fumble recoveries for touchdowns.

The 'Raiders have produced 61 sacks and forced 31 turnovers on the year. In addition, Mount Union has scored a national-best 13 defensive touchdowns (INTs or FR).

How They Got Here: Johns Hopkins earned the Centennial Conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Playoffs (a Pool A bid) and advanced to the semifinals with a 49-0 opening-round win over MIT, a 58-27 win over sixth-ranked Frostburg St. in the second round and a 37-14 win over 23rd-ranked RPI in the quarterfinals.

Mount Union earned the Ohio Athletic Conference automatic bid to the NCAA Playoffs (also a Pool A bid) and has topped Denison (60-0), Centre (51-35) and Muhlenberg (38-10 in its three playoff games).

A Program First: Johns Hopkins is making its first appearance in the NCAA Semifinals. The Blue Jays had advanced to the quarterfinals once prior to this season (2009), but dropped a 12-0 decision to then third-ranked Wesley in that game.

Did You Know: Sixth-ranked Frostburg St., which Johns Hopkins defeated 58-27 in the second round of the NCAA Playoffs, is the highest-ranked team Johns Hopkins has ever beaten in football. Previously, the highest-ranked team Johns Hopkins had ever beaten was then ninth-ranked McDaniel in 2001 (21-14).

Playoff Bound: Johns Hopkins is making its eighth straight trip to the NAAs, its ninth in 10 years and 10th overall. All 10 appearances have come since 2005.

Historically Speaking: Johns Hopkins improved to 13-10 overall in the post-season with last week's win against Frostburg. The Blue Jays are now 9-9 in the NCAA Playoffs and 4-1 in ECAC Bowl Games.

All-Centennial Jays

The Johns Hopkins football team was well represented on the 2018 All-Centennial Football Team, which was announced on November 13. The Blue Jays placed 14 players on the team, including nine first team picks, three second team selections and a pair of honorable mention honorees

In addition, junior quarterback **David Tammaro** was named the Centennial Offensive Player of the Year and freshman linebacker **Robert Fletcher** grabbed Rookie of the Year honors.

- **Johns Hopkins** is one of just seven schools in the nation - at all levels of the NCAA - that has produced more than **150 all-time CoSIDA Academic All-Americans** and **45 NCAA Postgraduate Scholarship recipients** while also winning at least **15 NCAA Championships** (among all sports). The other schools on that select list ... **Stanford, Notre Dame, Penn State, Nebraska, Florida and Emory (GA)**.
- The **Johns Hopkins football** program has produced **31 all-time CoSIDA Academic All-Americans**. Of those, 21 have come during the Blue Jays' 10-year run as Centennial Conference Champions (2009-18) and JHU has produced at least two Academic All-Americans every year since 2011.
- Johns Hopkins has finished in the **top 10 of the Learfield Directors' Cup standings seven times in the last eight years**. JHU is currently ranked first in the nation in the Division III Directors' Cup this fall and **Hopkins was the only school in the nation to have seven teams qualify for the NCAA Championships this fall** (men's & women's cross country, field hockey, football, men's & women's soccer, volleyball).
- Trophy Time - With its run to the semifinals, **the Blue Jay football team will be the third Johns Hopkins fall athletic team to bring home a trophy from an NCAA Tournament or championship this year**. The Blue Jay women's cross country team finished as national runner-up and the Hopkins field hockey team advanced to the final four for the first time in school history.

Margraff Holds State Record: Johns Hopkins head coach **Jim Margraff** became the winningest college football coach in Maryland state history with a 42-14 win at Ursinus late in the 2014 season as that gave him 175 career victories, a mark he upped to 221 with last week's win against RPI.

Margraff now sports a career record of 221-88-3 (.713) entering this week's NCAA Semifinal game against Mount Union.

Third Longest Streak: Johns Hopkins' eight consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament rank as the third-longest active streak in the nation. Only Mount Union (27) and Mary Hardin-Baylor (17) have currently made more consecutive appearances than Johns Hopkins.

What's Next: The winner of the Johns Hopkins-Mount Union semifinal game will play the winner of the semifinal game between Mary Hardin-Baylor and Wisconsin-Whitewater in the national championship game on Friday, December 14 (7 pm). That game will be played in Shenandoah, Texas and will air live on ESPNU.

Centennial Conference Champions: Johns Hopkins claimed its record 14th Centennial Conference title this season with all 14 championships coming since 2002. JHU's 14 CC titles are four more than Muhlenberg, which shared the title with the Blue Jays this season, has earned.

A Special Senior Class

This year's senior class will go down as one of the most accomplished in program history. Below is a look at some of their collective team achievements since arriving in 2015:



- JHU has won four Centennial Conference titles and appeared in the NCAA Playoffs in each of their four seasons.

- The Blue Jays have compiled a record of 43-5 since the current seniors arrived. The 43 wins are tied for the most in school history by one class.

- Johns Hopkins posted a 38-2 regular season record since the start of the 2015 season.

- The Blue Jays did not lose a regular season home game during their career.

Centennial Strong: Johns Hopkins is the second team in Centennial Conference history to advance to the NCAA Semifinals. Gettysburg advanced to the semifinals in 1985.

11 in a Row: Johns Hopkins ran its winning streak to 11 games with last week's 37-14 win over 23rd-ranked RPI in the NCAA Quarterfinals.

This marks the eighth time since **Jim Margraff** took over as the head coach at Johns Hopkins (1990) that the Blue Jays have had a winning streak of 10 games or longer and the seventh of 11 games or longer. Prior to Margraff's arrival, Johns Hopkins had never won more than seven games in a row.

Blue Jays Break Scoring Record: Johns Hopkins' 58-point outburst against Frostburg St. pushed the Blue Jays' season scoring total to 584 points, a mark that broke the previous school record of 548 points in 2015 (12 games). The Blue Jays pushed their season scoring total to 621 points with last week's 37-point showing against RPI.

The 2015 and 2018 seasons are the only two seasons in school history in which Johns Hopkins has scored 500 or more points.

Among the National Leaders: Entering this week's game against Mount Union, Johns Hopkins ranks first in the nation in total offense (564.4), fourth in passing offense (340.5) and fifth in scoring offense (47.8). The Blue Jays also rank sixth in third-down percentage (.509) and the 349 first downs JHU has accumulated are the most of any team in the nation.

Six in 132, Nine in 24: In the first 132 seasons of Johns Hopkins football, the Blue Jays had six games of 600+ yards of total offense. In the last 24 games, the Blue Jays have topped the 600-yard mark nine times.

Record-Breaking: Johns Hopkins extended its school single-season record of 600-yard games to six with a 647-yard outburst against Frostburg St. in the second round of the NCAA Playoffs. The Blue Jays had never previously had more than three 600-yard games in one season prior to this year.

Best Passing Season in School History: Johns Hopkins quarterbacks have combined to throw for 4,426 yards in 13 games this season. The 4,426 yards rank as the highest single-season total in school history; the previous record of 4,106 yards was set in 12 games in 2016.

Blue Jays Break Touchdown Record: With seven touchdowns in the 49-0 win against MIT in the first round of the playoffs, eight more at Frostburg St. and five last week against RPI, Johns Hopkins has now scored 88 touchdowns on the year. That breaks the previous school single-season record of 75, which was set in 2015.

Balanced Scoring: Johns Hopkins' 88 touchdowns this season are split nearly even as the Blue Jays count 46 rushing touchdowns and 39 passing touchdowns on the year (JHU also scored once each on a blocked punt return, interception and fumble return). Only once previously (2015) had JHU scored 35 or more touchdowns on the ground and through the air (the 2015 team had 38 rushing TDs and 36 passing TDs).

40+: Johns Hopkins has scored 40 or more points 10 times this season; that breaks the previous school record of nine (2016).

Series History

Johns Hopkins and Mount Union are meeting for the third time in a series that dates to a 55-13 win by the Purple Raiders in 2012.

Both previous meetings in the series also came in the NCAA Playoffs as Mount Union's 2012 win came in the second round, while the Purple Raiders also edged the Blue Jays, 28-21, in the second round in 2016.

Big Plays: Through 13 games, the Johns Hopkins offense has 104 plays of 20 yards or longer (an average of 8.0 such plays per game) and 274 plays of 10 yards or longer (21.1 such plays per game). Note that this includes offensive plays only (rushing and passing plays).

It's Been a While - Part I: The shutout for the Blue Jays in the 56-0 win at Juniata on November 3 was the first road shutout for Johns Hopkins since October 13, 2012, when JHU topped Dickinson, 49-0.

Notable Johns Hopkins Graduates

John Astin '52- Actor best known for his role as Gomez Addams in the Addams Family.

Michael Bloomberg '64 - Former Mayor of New York City ... recently made a \$1.8 billion gift to Johns Hopkins for undergraduate financial aid.

Andy Enfield '91 - Men's Basketball coach at USC. Graduated as the NCAA's career record-holder in free thrown percentage (.925) after hitting 431-of-466 in his career.

Hallie Jackson '06 - Currently the Chief White House correspondent for NBC News.

Sam Palmisano '73 - Former Blue Jay football team captain (played center) who went on to become the CEO of IBM.

Bill Stromberg '82 - The only Johns Hopkins football player inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame (WR). Played all four years at JHU with current head coach Jim Margraff and one of the final cuts by the Philadelphia Eagles in 1982. Currently the President and CEO of T. Rowe Price in Baltimore.

It's Been a While - Part II: The 56-0 win at Juniata was JHU's largest shutout victory since September 19, 1997, when the Blue Jays topped Swarthmore 73-0.

Twice in Three Weeks: Johns Hopkins notched its second shutout of the season with the 49-0 win against MIT in the first round of the NCAA Playoffs. That gives the Blue Jays two shutouts in the same season for the first time since 2011.

Seven or Less Under Rehring: Since **Mickey Rehring** took over as the Blue Jay defensive coordinator in 2013, Johns Hopkins has held the opposition to seven points or less 16 times - including the three-point performance by Moravian on September 15, the six-point effort by Ursinus a week later, the shutout at Juniata on November 3 and the shutout against MIT in the first round of the playoffs.

123 in 11: After allowing an average of 34 points per game in the first two games, the Blue Jay defense has worked its way into form and has allowed a total of just 123 points in the last 11 games - all Blue Jay victories.

Defense Fuels Win Over Muhlenberg: The Johns Hopkins defense forced six

turnovers and totaled three sacks and 11 pass breakups to fuel the 27-16 victory over 22nd-ranked Muhlenberg. The Blue Jays last forced six or more turnovers in 2010 and the 11 pass breakups are the most by Johns Hopkins since the Jays had 11 in a win against McDaniel in 2005. Hopkins held the Mules 21 points and more than 120 yards below their season averages entering the game.

Sack Party: The Johns Hopkins defense has totaled 40 sacks on the year, including 30 in the last eight games. With six sacks at Franklin & Marshall and five at Gettysburg, the Blue Jays had five or more sacks in back-to-back games for the first time since notching six against Randolph-Macon and five against Susquehanna early in the 2012 season. The Blue Jays added three in the win against Muhlenberg, six at Juniata, four against McDaniel, one against MIT, two against Frostburg. St. and three against RPI.

Walters Breaks TD Records: Senior running back **Stuart Walters** is Johns Hopkins' career record-holder for overall (57) and rushing touchdowns (47). The previous records of 51 (overall) and 44 (rushing) were held Andrew Kase (2006-09), who powered the Blue Jays to the 2009 NCAA Quarterfinals.

PK Enters the Record Book - Part I: Junior defensive back **Patrick Kelly** intercepted a Gettysburg pass on the last play of the game and returned it 90 yards before being tackled. The 90-yard interception return is the longest in school history - 10 yards longer than **Les Matthews'** 80-yard return against then Western Maryland (McDaniel) on November 18, 1972.

GAME 14 - JOHNS HOPKINS at MOUNT UNION

PK Enters the Record Book - Part II: Not only did **Patrick Kelly** set a Johns Hopkins record with a 90-yard interception return at Gettysburg, he also became the first player in school history with two different types of 90+ yard plays. Kelly had a 95-yard kickoff return for a touchdown against Gettysburg last season and added the 90-yard INT return this season.

The only other player in school history with two 90-yard plays is **Harrison Bernstein**, who had kickoff returns of 95 and 92 yards during his career from 1996-99.

Block Party: Freshman **Robert Fletcher** needed exactly three minutes to impact the first game of his career as he blocked a Randolph-Macon punt that was returned 32 yards for a touchdown by senior **Tyler Messinger**. The blocked punt return for a touchdown was the first for Johns Hopkins since **Adam Schweyer** took one back 36 yards for a score against Juniata on October 30, 2010.

Fletcher was back at it against Dickinson as he partially blocked a first-quarter Red Devil punt that led to a Johns Hopkins touchdown and also got a piece of Franklin & Marshall's first punt to give him three blocks on the year; he is tied for 11th in the nation with his three blocked kicks.

More Blocks: Johns Hopkins has blocked a total of eight kicks on the year. That ties the Blue Jays for seventh in the nation entering this week's game against Mount Union.

Pick Six: Sophomore **Macauley Kilbane** scored the second of four, fourth-quarter touchdowns for the Blue Jays in the season-opener against Randolph-Macon as he returned an interception 34 yards for a score with 13:20 remaining.

The interception return for a score was the first for the Blue Jays since **Dan Johnson's** 23-yard return for a touchdown against F&M on November 7, 2013.

Because You'll Ask - Part I: For the record, the last time Johns Hopkins scored a touchdown on offense, defense and special teams - prior to turning the trick in the season-opener against Randolph-Macon - was on November 10, 2007, when **Richard Hill** returned the opening kickoff 90 yards for a touchdown, **Adam Winter** returned an interception 12 yards for a score and the Blue Jay offense scored a pair of touchdowns in a 31-3 win at McDaniel.

Because You'll Ask - Part II: With the three returns for touchdowns this season (FR, INT, Blocked PR), Johns Hopkins has now scored 49 touchdowns on returns since head coach **Jim Margraff** took over in 1990 (see chart to right for complete list).

Record-Tying: Senior punter **Brandon Hong-Dominguez** tied the Johns Hopkins record for the longest punt in school history with a 75-yard bomb late in the fourth quarter against Dickinson. It is just the fifth 70+ yard punt in school history and tied **Ben Scott's** school record (vs. Rochester / 2005).

At Home at Homewood: Johns Hopkins has parlayed its home field advantage into victories in recent years. In fact, the Blue Jays are 50-5 (.909) in the home blacks since the start of the 2010 season.

Number Four: Johns Hopkins boasts a 64-7 record since the start of the 2013 season. The Blue Jays' .901 winning percentage over that time ranks fourth among Division III teams. In order, the top five teams in the nation in winning percentage since the start of the 2013 season (records included):

61 Under to 61 Over: Johns Hopkins head coach **Jim Margraff** inherited a program with an all-time record that was 61 games **UNDER** .500 when he arrived (334-395-56). With the win against Juniata on November 4, 2017, Johns Hopkins moved its all-time record to 61 games **OVER** .500. Entering this week's game against Mount Union, Johns Hopkins has an all-time record of 555-483-59 (+72).

Close Calls: Since the start of the 2013 season, Johns Hopkins has lost a total of seven games. Those seven losses have come by five, three, five, seven, four, three and two points (including playoff games). Translation ... JHU has lost seven games in 5+ seasons by a total of 29 points.

On a Roll: Johns Hopkins is 81-3 in its last 84 regular season games dating back to late in the 2010 season and 88-10 in its last 98 games overall since late in the 2010 season.

Sustained Success: Since the start of the 2002 season, the Blue Jays sport a 155-38 (.803) record. Taking it back farther, the Blue Jays are 161-41 (.797) since the start of the 2001 season and 166-46 (.783) since the beginning of the 2000 season.

It's All Academic

The Johns Hopkins football team dominated the 2018 CoSIDA Academic All-District II Football Team when it was announced on November 15. Johns Hopkins' eight selections were tied for the most in the nation among Division III schools (Carnegie Mellon).

This is the 10th consecutive year that the Johns Hopkins football program has produced six or more Academic All-District selections and pushes the Blue Jays' total to 108 Academic All-District selections in the last 16 years and 134 selections since 1991.

During JHU's current 10-year run at the top of the Centennial Conference the Blue Jays have now produced 79 Academic All-District players.

To be eligible for CoSIDA Academic All-District honors, a student-athlete must have at least a 3.30 cumulative GPA, be a sophomore or above and a starter or significant reserve.
