

## PAR's Author Agreement Term

The Perioperative Anesthesia Reports (PAR) adheres to the Instructions to Authors which state that only original articles that have not been previously published, except as academic theses or abstracts presented at conferences or meetings, and are not under consideration by any other journal, will be accepted.

By signing this Agreement, the Author(s) guarantees that they own the copyright and, in case of acceptance, the Author(s) assigns to PAR the right to publish and distribute the manuscript, either in part or in its entirety, in print, electronic, and all other media, in any form, and in all languages, worldwide, throughout the full term of copyright.

1. The Author(s) ensure:

1.1 The manuscript has been submitted solely to PAR and has not been published in any other journal. The Article, which has been written by the designated authors, is original and has not been published previously. The Article was not under review by any other journal during the review process at PAR and will not be submitted to any other journal.

1.2 The Article and the Supplemental Materials do not infringe any copyright, violate any other intellectual property, privacy or other rights of any person or entity, or contain any injurious or other unlawful matter. The Author(s) has written permission from copyright owners for any excerpts from copyrighted works that are included and have credited the sources in the Article or the Supplemental Materials.

1.6 The Author(s) accepts complete liability for any damages that may result from the work assigned to SAESP/PAR, and in the event that SAESP/PAR is challenged in court due to the work assigned, particularly but not limited to cases of third-party infringement, the Author will be responsible for covering all legal expenses related to the provision of appropriate extrajudicial and/or judicial defenses, including court costs and any other expenses arising from any unfavorable outcome.

2. The Author(s):
