

CAKE WALK

- 1. Make a giant cake out of paper, either a 2D one or get creative and make a 3D cake. (You can also copy the cake on the last page of *The Night Before the 100th Day of School.*)
- 2. Have your students make ants. If you want to turn it into a 100th Day activity and you have an amount of students that divides evenly into 100, you can have the students figure out how many ants each one should make. For instance, if you have 20 students, each one will make 5 ants.
- 3. Stick the ants to the cake. You might want to make a line of ants leading to the cake.
- 4. Or, you can stick the ants all around your classroom while your students are out of the room and see if the kids can find them. Note: number the ants first so you know if they found all 100.
