PARTIAL DAY Guided Fishing Trips (5-7 hrs)

Great for kids and those guests worried about a long day of seasickness.

Saltwater Halibut Fishing – \$600/pp

Comfortable boat equipped rods, reels, bait and tackle for bottom fishing.

No halibut on Tuesdays or Wednesdays, 2-fish limit including one fish under 28"

Saltwater Salmon Fishing – \$600/pp

Comfortable boat equipped with downriggers, trolling gear, rods, reels, bait and tackle.

Freshwater Fishing, Hike-In – \$600/pp

Boat to a nearby creek and hike in with your guide for a fish and fun-filled adventure.

Paddle Tour of Halibut Cove – always included

Customized guided tour on the water around our little island community by ocean kayak, sea cycle, stand up paddleboard (SUP). Learn about the interesting history and ecology of this thriving seaside village.

Hike Halibut Cove's local Native Trail – always included

Customized guided interpretive hike along our own 2-mile panoramic trail with forest and coastal views overlooking Halibut Cove. Includes berry picking July-September.

HALF-DAY Guided Excursions (3-4 hrs)

2-person minimum

Wildlife Cruise and/or Local Fishing by Boat – \$420/pp

Customized guided boat tour through the coves and inlets of Halibut Cove viewing seals, otters, eagles, whales, seabirds and other marine creatures with snacks and cozy beverages.

Museums, Galleries and Shopping in Homer by Boat – \$420/pp

Cruise 20 minutes to the cosmic hamlet of nearby Homer and spend some time exploring your choice of cultural stops along the way. Includes private vehicle and driver.

Boat and Hike: Grewingk Glacier Lake – \$420/pp

Half-day guided adventure: boat to the trailhead and hike 1.5 miles to the iceberg filled lake with gigantic Grewingk Glacier as the backdrop. (Trail Rating: Easy-Moderate)

Boat (or Kayak) and Hike: Glacier Spit Beach-Combing – \$420/pp

Half-day guided adventure: Kayak or boat to miles of ocean beach. Discover enchanting driftwood, unique sea-stones and coastal wildlife. Build a bonfire and enjoy a picnic.

FULL-DAY Guided Excursions (8-10 hrs)

2-person minimum

Boat, Hike and Kayak: Glacier Lake Kayaking – \$600/pp ★ Guest Favorite

Full day guided adventure: 10 min. boat to the trailhead, hike 6 miles round trip to Grewingk Glacier Lake, kayak with icebergs 2 miles round trip to picnic atop a scenic glacier overlook. Towering mountains, blue ice and stable inflatable kayaks. (Trail Rating: Moderate)

Kayak and Hike: Halibut Cove Lagoon – \$600/pp

Feel the excitement of a unique tidal river, then hike over the ridge into the next fjord or numerous other interesting destinations. Customized, full day tide dependent adventure for the experienced paddler. Includes berry picking July-September (Trail rating: Moderate)

Boat and Mountain Climb Hike: Summit Alpine Ridge OR Grace Ridge – \$600/pp

Full-day guided ascent up a rugged mountain trail, through forest and above tree line to unforgettable alpine views of Kachemak Bay. Boat or kayak to trailhead. (Trail Rating: Difficult)

Boat, Bike and Hike: Mountain Bike or Alaskan Fat Bike – \$600/pp

Boat through a scenic ocean passage then disembark for a guided ride on the bike of your choice. Peddle along remote logging roads that lead to lively lunch options at the nearby village of Seldovia. Pick some berries on an optional after-lunch hike through the old growth forest. Then, enjoy a relaxing boat ride back to the lodge. (Rating: Moderate Biking & Hiking)



Bear Viewing, Float Plane and Helicopter

Bear Viewing

Aircraft subject to availability, conditions and location of bears.
2-passenger minimum

Float Plane Bear Viewing (7-8 hours) – \$1,200/pp

2 to 20 passengers – Take off right from our dock via float plane across scenic Cook Inlet to the Alaska Peninsula and the largest brown bear population in the world. Land in a remote mountain lake in Lake Clark or Katmai National Park depending on the time of year and location of the bears. Includes gear and lunch and the flight seeing en route is always incredible.

Heli Bear Viewing (5-6 hours) – \$1,200/pp

2 to 3 passengers – Fly from our private nearby helipad across scenic Cook Inlet to Lake Clark or Katmai National Park... just you and the bears up close and personal. Walking up to a mile in hip waders and an adventurous spirit required.
