

Molestation charges against Poulsbo man dropped

PORT ORCHARD —Kitsap County prosecutors have dropped child molestation charges against Daniel E. Sluys, 53, of Poulsbo.

In early January, he was accused of inappropriately touching a young girl he knew.

Kitsap County Senior Deputy Prosecutor Kevin Hull said prosecutors did not believe they could prove a case beyond a reasonable doubt due to inconsistent witness statements.

"It has been a nightmare and I am glad to move on," Sluys said in a statement released by his attorney, David Allen. "I hope that people in the community will afford me the presumption of innocence, especially now that this case has been dismissed."
