

We are looking for motivated housekeepers to join our team!

Who we are: Tonglen Lake Lodge is a small, upscale lodge located just minutes away from Denali National Park. We are a seasonally run operation (mid-May through mid-September) with an onsite cafe and guest accommodations that include 11 private cabins and 5 guest rooms. Our Artisan Café and beautiful grounds are open to the public each morning and draw local artisans, community members, and performers for special events. Our team includes 10-12 seasonal staff and a small year-round team. Tonglen is a unique and beautiful place to spend the summer.

Duties include:

- Daily turn-over of guest cabins and rooms.
- Sweep, scrub, and mop floors.
- Vacuum and clean carpets, rugs, and draperies.
- Dust and clean furniture, fixtures, and fittings.
- Empty and clean trash containers, and dispose of trash in a sanitary manner.
- Clean sinks, mirrors, tubs and showers.
- Wipe down glass surfaces.
- Make up beds and change linens as required.
- Tidy up guest cabins and rooms.
- Feng Shui both indoor and outdoor public spaces.
- Garden and yard upkeep: mow the lawn, weed the trails, etc.
- Wash windows as scheduled.
- Sort, wash, load, unload, and fold laundry.
- Iron and press clothing and linen.
- Operate mechanized cleaning equipment.
- Maintain all cleaning equipment and materials in a safe and sanitary working condition.
- Monitor and report necessary repairs and replacements.

Requirements:

- Detail and deadline oriented with a strong work ethic.
- Must be able to work on a team (housekeepers work in pairs).
- Capable of organizing daily tasks in an efficient way.
- Ability to interact respectfully with coworkers, guests, and lodge visitors.
- Flexibility.
- Task-driven and able to anticipate what needs to be done.
- Positive attitude and interest in contributing talents and energy towards our operations.
- Physically capable of lifting/carrying 50 pounds, being on your feet for an eight-hour shift, walking up and down flights of stairs, pulling carts on slopes over gravel, and working outside in all kinds of weather.
